Objectives:

At the end of this lesson the student will be able to:

- use past simple negative form in sentences.
- use past simple interrogative & short answers form in sentences.

Past simple negative



First, read the examples and find out the grammatical rule.

I didn't watch the show last night.

He didn't walk to school last week.

They didn't play tennis yesterday.

All the sentences are in the past simple.

Think! What did we add before the main verbs? Did we change or add anything to the main verbs?

Task 1

Now change the affirmative sentences to negative, then check the correct answer.

Affirmative form sentences	Negative form sentences
She visited her grandfather last Sunday.	She didn't visit her grandfather last Sunday.
I studied for an exam this morning.	I didn't study for the exam this morning.
My mother baked a cake last night.	My mother didn't bake a cake last night.
They rented a lovely flat in 2002.	They didn't rent a lovely flat in 2002.
I changed my clothes two hours ago.	I didn't change my clothes two hours ago.

Task 2

Assessment:

Write full sentences using the past simple negative form. Write at least 6 sentences with different verbs from the previous activity, then check the suggested answer.

1	I didn't go to my grandmother's house yesterday.
2	Amal didn't wash her jacket last Sunday.
3	Ben didn't drive to the city last holiday.
4	They didn't invite all their friends to the party last summer.
5	I didn't have a shower this morning.
6	Tom and Peter didn't listen to music last night.

Past simple interrogative & short answers



First, read the examples and find out the grammatical rule.

All the questions are in the past simple.

- Did you watch the show last night?** **Yes, I did.**
- Did he walk to school last week?** **No, he didn't.**
- Did they play tennis yesterday?** **Yes, they did.**

Think! Where did we put "Did"?
Did we change or add anything
to the main verbs? What did we
put at the end of the questions?:
full-stops or question marks?
Are the answers long or short?

Task 3

Now read the questions & answers below, then correct the mistakes, then check the correct answer.

Did your father build your house in 1999. Yes, he did.	Did your father build your house in 1999? Yes, he did.
