Girl: No. I have a piano class that day. But I think Tuesday I have nothing to do, is it ok?  
Man: That is wonderful, thanks.

### 5. What was Bob doing on Monday?

- Girl: What did you do on Monday?  
Man: I don't know. Oh yes, I was at home.  
Girl: Did you clean your bedroom?  
Man: No. I tried doing my homework. But I found out I have a test on Tuesday.  
Girl: So what did you do then?

Man: I stayed studying until late at night.
