Sleeping disorders

Most of us have experienced trouble sleeping at one time or another. This is normal and usually temporary, due to stress or other outside factors. But if sleep problems are a regular occurrence and interfere with your daily life, you may be suffering from a sleep disorder.

There are many different problems you can have with sleeping. Some are medical problems where you need to see a doctor, others are just annoying.

Sleepwalking is probably the most common sleeping disorder. It can be just sitting up in bed while you are asleep or walking around and doing activities, where accidents can happen. These activities can be normal activities like walking to the bathroom or cleaning or doing dangerous activities like cooking and driving a car.

Some people have even said they were sleepwalking when they committed a crime. Sleepwalking can last from 30 seconds to 30 minutes. Sleepwalkers show no emotion on their faces and their eyes are open. However, they don't remember anything when they wake up.

Insomnia is not being able to sleep. This happens to most people at some point, but when it lasts for a long time, it can be bad for your health. The Guinness World Records used to have world records for people staying awake, but they stopped because it is too dangerous. Some people have somniphobia, which is the fear of sleeping. They are too scared to go to sleep, perhaps because of nightmares that they have had or sometimes they are scared they will die in their sleep. Narcolepsy, on the other hand, is not being able to stay awake. People with this disorder often do not sleep well at night. This causes them to be so tired during the day that they cannot stop themselves from falling asleep. Obviously, this can be quite embarrassing.




Amazing Creatures

Our Planet is home to about 30 million different kinds of animals. They are beautiful, they are special and they always amaze us!

Chameleons live in a variety of habitats, from rain forests and lowlands to deserts, semi-deserts, and even mountains. Many inhabit trees, but some live in grass or on small bushes, fallen leaves, or dry branches. They eat bugs and they are famous for their ability to change colour, their sticky tongue, and their eyes which can be moved into different directions at the same time. This helps them to spot their enemies and their food. As a chameleon grows, its skin does not. When it gets tight, they lose it. Their old skin is quite tasty so they often eat it. Yummy! If you see a chameleon sleeping during the day, or with one or both eyes closed, then it is sick. They never sleep during the day.

Crocodiles are large reptiles found in tropical regions of Africa, Asia, the Americas and Australia. They normally live near lakes, rivers, wetlands and even some saltwater regions. They run fast and sometimes jump to catch their food. When they see their food, they open their strong jaws and swallow it. The food goes straight down to their stomach. Crocodiles grow new teeth to replace their old ones all the times but they never clean their teeth and they cannot move their tongues!

Seahorses or “hippocampus” mainly live in shallow tropical and temperate waters throughout the world. They are found in Pacific waters from North America to South America. They can change colour to protect themselves from enemies. Male seahorses are the only males on the planet that have babies! The female leaves her eggs in the male’s pouch. The male carries them for a month. After one month, a thousand of tiny babies come to life. Seahorses have one partner during their lifetime. Each morning the couples dance together. Their dance usually lasts for several minutes.
