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Present Perfect Continuous

The present perfect continuous is formed by using **has/have + been + present participle**.

Statement:

I, We, You, They	have	been	Waiting here for two hours.
He, She, It	has	been	Waiting here for two hours.

Negative:

I, We, You, They	have	not	been	Waiting here for two hours.
He, She, It	has	not	been	Waiting here for two hours.

Question:

Have	I, we, you, they	been	Waiting here for two hours	?
Has	He, she, it	been	Waiting here for two hours	?

Present Perfect Continuous Uses:



- We use the present perfect continuous to show that something started in the past and has continued up until now.

Examples:

- They **have been talking** since 8 a.m.
- She **has been working** at that company for three years.
- What **have you been doing** for the last 30 minutes?
- James **has been teaching** at the university since June.
- We **have been waiting** here for over two hours!
- Why **has** Nancy **not been taking** her medicine for the last three days?

- Present perfect continuous focus on activities rather than results.

She has been baking cakes for two hours.

- Present perfect continuous says how long.

I have been reading this book all day.

- It describes an activity that may continue.

I've writing an e-mail.

- Present perfect continuous used when the result comes out from the action itself, this result is often something we can see, hear, smell or feel.

She has been doing her homework, so she's tired.
