Introduction to Reported Speech

Examples

- She **says** she likes music.
- He **tells** me he is upset.

Direct Speech : " I am a doctor."

Indirect Speech: He says (that)he is a doctor.

Direct Speech : " I like pasta."

Indirect Speech: He said he liked pasta.

Direct Speech : " I am sick *today*."

Indirect Speech: He said he was sick *that day*.

this	that
these	those
today	that day
yesterday	the day before
tomorrow	the next/following day
last week/month/year	the previous week/month/year
next week/month/year	the following week/month/year
now	then
here	there

Tense	Statement	Reported Speech
Simple Present	<i>I like oranges.</i>	<i>He said that he liked oranges.</i>
Present Continuous	<i>I am swimming.</i>	<i>She said that she was swimming.</i>
Present Perfect	<i>I have seen the movie.</i>	<i>He said that he had seen the movie.</i>
Simple Past	<i>I forgot to bring my lunch.</i>	<i>She said that she forgot her lunch OR she said that she had forgotten her lunch.</i>
Past Continuous	<i>I was looking for the train station.</i>	<i>He said that she had been looking for the train station.</i>
Past Perfect	<i>I had finished the letter before they arrived.</i>	<i>She said that she had finished the letter before they arrived.</i>
Simple Future	<i>I will move to New York.</i>	<i>He said that he would move to New York.</i>
Future Continuous	<i>I will be hanging out with someone.</i>	<i>She said that she would be hanging out with someone.</i>
Future Perfect	<i>I will have forgotten about it by tomorrow.</i>	<i>He said that he would have forgotten about it by tomorrow.</i>
Present Perfect Continuous	<i>I have been waiting in line.</i>	<i>She said that she had been waiting in line.</i>

can	could
will	would
may	might
must	must/had to
should	should
ought to	ought to
might	might

Direct Speech : " Where are you going?"

Indirect Speech: He asked me **where** I was going.

Direct Speech : " Are you happy?"

Indirect Speech: He asked me **if/whether** I was happy.
