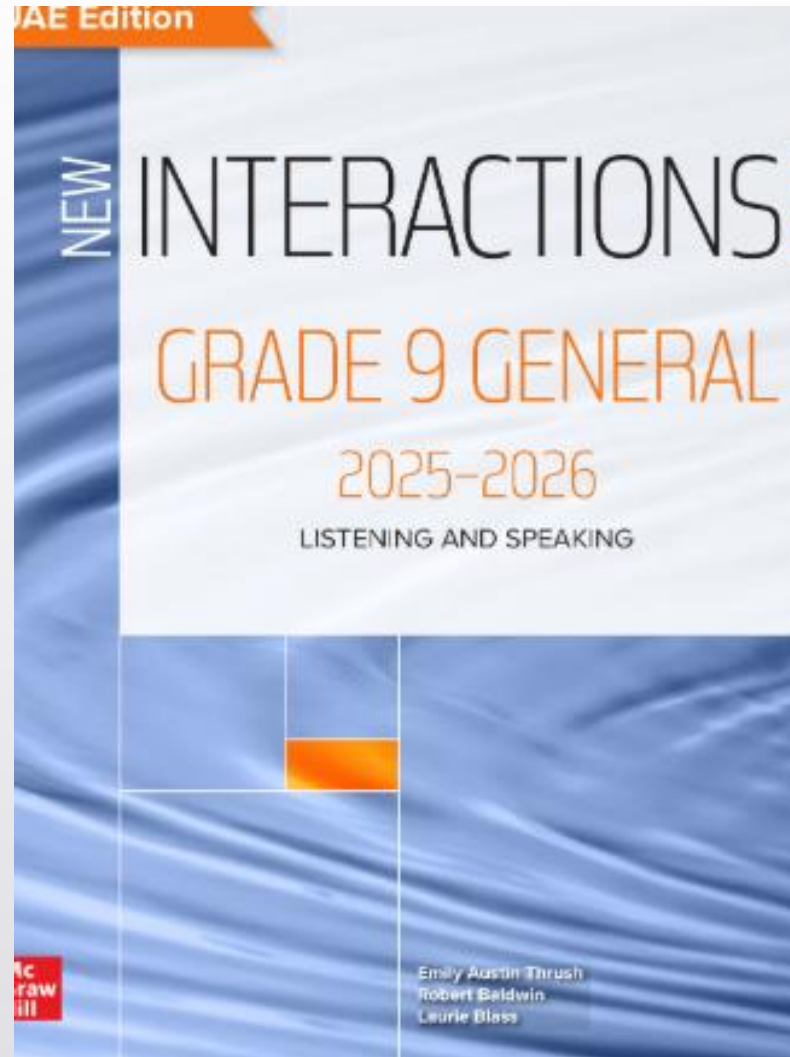

Visualizing

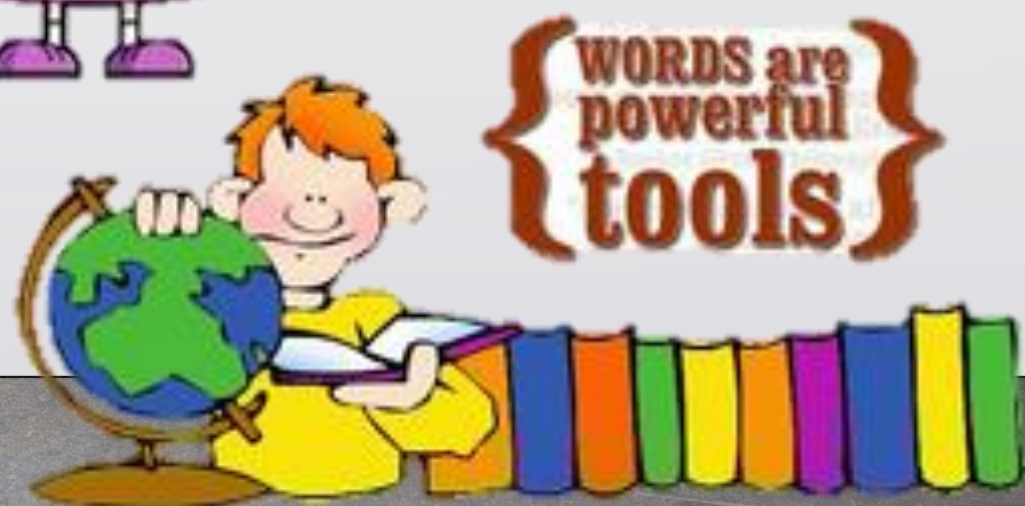
When you listen to directions, it is a good idea to visualize them. Try to “see” a picture in your mind of the directions and the places the speaker talks about.

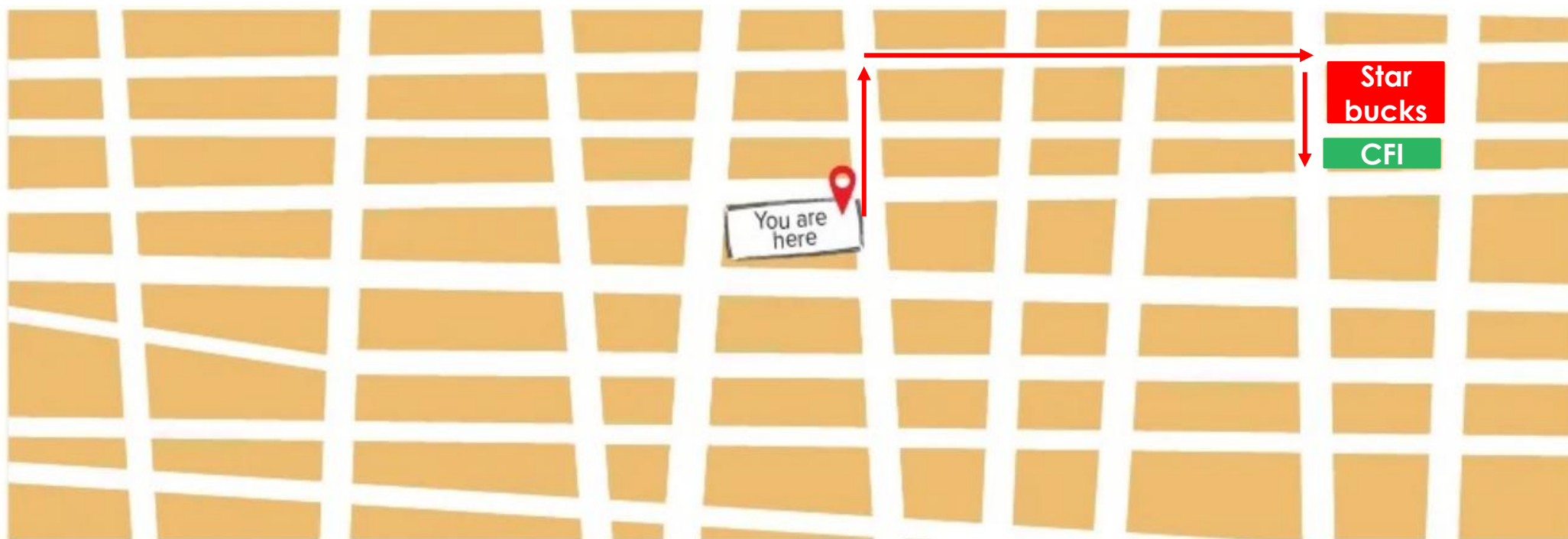
