Ahmad ibn Majid

Ahmad ibn Majid was a famous Arab sailor and traveller. He was born around 1432 in Julfar (Ras al Khaimah). His family were sailors, and he was sailing huge ships when he was only seventeen. He has been famous for his sailing skills since he was young.

At that time, sailing was very dangerous. Strong winds and high waves could destroy ships. Sailors needed strength and skill to survive. During his trips, Ahmad ibn Majid used the stars and a metal star chart to find his way. This was more difficult than following today's sailing directions but was better than other tools of that time.

Ahmad ibn Majid wrote many interesting books and poems about his voyages. His most important book was *Kitab al-Fawa'id*. It was a simple guide to help sailors. The new routes in the book were faster and safer than the old ones. They helped sailors travel to India and East Africa.

His books also shared useful knowledge for sailors. He wrote about the *kamal*, a small tool made of wood and rope. When sailors were using it, they knew where they were at sea. He explained how wind changes the speed of a ship and makes it go faster. He also recorded 39 places along the coast from East Africa to India. His details were clearer and better than older guides and became very popular.

Many different people have used Ahmad ibn Majid's advice since he wrote his books. Sailors are still reading about his work and how he made sea travel safer.
