

Wild animals have special body parts that help them survive in nature. The penguin has strong flippers and a smooth body. These help the penguin swim very well in cold water. Penguins cannot fly, but they are excellent swimmers. The hippo has a big body and strong legs. These help it walk and move in water. Hippos also have large mouths and strong teeth to eat plants. The wolf has strong legs and sharp teeth. These help the wolf run fast and hunt for food. Wolves also have thick fur to keep warm. The cheetah has long legs and a flexible body. These help it run very fast. The cheetah is the fastest land animal. All animals use their body parts to swim, walk, or run.

Wild animals live in different places. They can do special things because they need to survive. Lions and cheetahs live in hot grasslands. They can run very fast and they can climb trees well. The cheetah is the fastest land animal in the world. Hippos live in rivers. They can swim and stay underwater for a long time. They can run fast but they can't climb trees. Gorillas live in rainforests. They can climb trees very well, but they can't swim. Bears and wolves live in forests. Bears can catch fish. Wolves can run far because they move in groups called packs. Bears can climb but wolves can't climb tall trees. Eagles live in mountains. They can fly high and see far. Dolphins live in the ocean. They can jump and swim fast. Penguins live in very cold places. They can swim but they can't fly because their wings are small.
