A long time ago, people used their hands, arms, and fingers to measure how tall or wide things were. For example, a chair might be 2 arms and 5 fingers high. Today, we use rulers to measure instead. In our classroom, we measured the height of a triangle, and it was 30 cm. We also measured the width of a square, and it was 20 cm. Measuring helps us know the right size of things.

A praying mantis is an insect. Praying mantises have a triangle-shaped head, a long neck, and a very long body. They hold their front legs in a way that looks like they are praying.

Praying mantises have five eyes. They eat insects and other small animals. They can eat crickets, spiders, frogs, and even small birds.

Praying mantises are usually green or brown. Their body shape helps them hide by looking like a branch or a leaf. You can find praying mantises in warm places. Their life begins as an egg, and they live for about one year.

A butterfly is an insect. Butterflies have four big wings and a long, thin body. Their wings are covered in tiny scales that create beautiful colors and patterns. They use their long, tubelike tongue to drink nector from flowers.

Butterflies go through stages in their life cycle: egg, caterpillar, pupa, and adult. They live in warm places and can be found in gardens, fields, and forests, where you can see lots of butterflies. Butterflies with bright colors can warn animals not to eat them, Some butterflies look like leaves to hide.






