Adjectives tell us more about a noun.
When we use more than one
adjective, we follow this order:

Adjective Order

Number	Size	Shape	Colour
--------	------	-------	--------

Present Modals

We use **must**, **mustn't**, **should**, **shouldn't** to talk about rules and advice.

must = something very important (You **must** listen to the teacher.)

mustn't = not allowed (You **mustn't** shout in class.)

should = good advice (You **should** do your homework.)

shouldn't = bad idea (You **shouldn't** run in the hallway.)

Imperatives

Positive
(Do something):

- Sit down.
- Open your book.



Negative
(Don't do something):

- Don't run in the hallway.
- Don't shout in class.
- Don't be late.



Imperatives
are sentences that tell someone (rules, instructions).

They usually **start with a verb**.
We **don't use a subject** (no "you")
