4. Question form:

👉 Use **Do** with (I/You/We/They) and **Does** with (He/She/It).

- **Does** she **like** pizza?

Adverbs of frequency tell us **how often** something happens.
They answer the question: "**How often?**"

Adverb	Meaning	Percentage	Example
Always	every time	100%	I always brush my teeth. ☐
Usually	most of the time	90%	I usually eat breakfast at 8. 🔍
Often	many times	70%	I often play football. ⚽
Sometimes	not always	50%	I sometimes watch TV. 📺
Never	not at all	0%	I never smoke. 🚫

💡 Word Order:

We put the adverb **before the main verb**, but after "am / is / are."

✅ Examples:

- I **always** do my homework.
- She **usually** goes to school by bus.
- We **sometimes** eat pizza.
- They **often** visit their grandma.

I **am** **always** happy.

She **is** **usually** lazy.

We **are** **sometimes** outside.

They **are** **often** funny.
