





Adverbs of Frequency

Adverbs of frequency tell us **how often** something happens. They answer the question: "How often?"



Adverb	Meaning	Percentage	Example
Always	every time	100%	I always brush my teeth. □
Usually	most of the time	90%	I usually eat breakfast at 8. Q
Often	many times	70%	I often play football. 🚱
Sometimes	not always	50%	I sometimes watch TV.
Never	not at all	0%	I never smoke. 🛇

Word Order:

We put the adverb before the main verb, but after "am / is / are."

Examples:

- I <u>always</u> do my homework.
- She <u>usually</u> goes to school by bus.
- We sometimes eat pizza.
- They often visit their grandma.

I <mark>am</mark> <u>always</u> happy.

She is <u>usually</u> lazy.

We are sometimes outside.

They are often funny.
