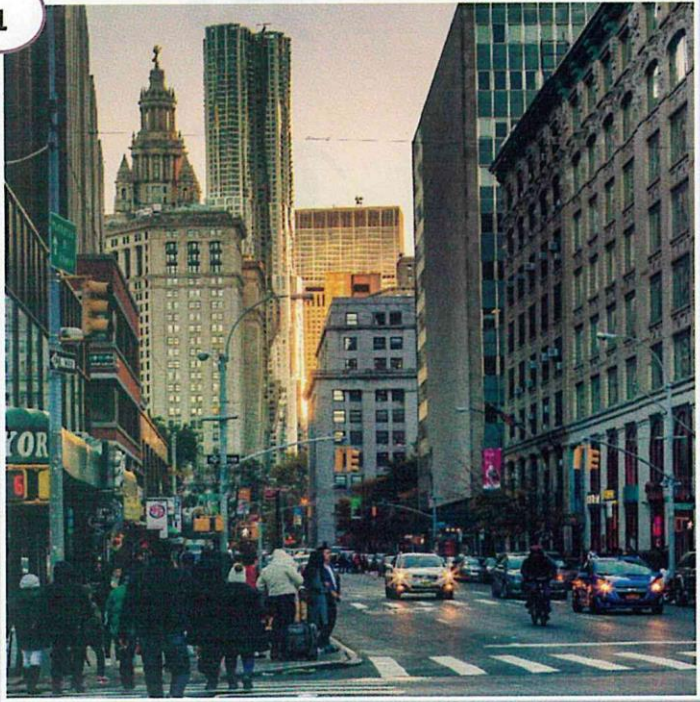
Meaning of vocabulary:

- **Mountain:** A very high hill, often with steep sides.
- **Road:** A path for vehicles and people to travel on.
- **Tree:** A tall plant with a trunk, branches, and leaves.
- **Lake:** A large area of water surrounded by land.
- **Building:** A structure with walls and a roof, like a house or office.
- **Bicycle:** A vehicle with two wheels that you ride by pedaling.
- **Shop:** A place where you can buy things.

Mira: “This is where I live. There are big buildings. There are people. There are cars and roads. There are shops. There aren’t any trees.”

Noor: “This is where I live. There is a lake. There are mountains. There are lots of trees. There are houses. There aren’t any big buildings.”

Language Tip

For one thing:

There is / There isn't (is not)

There isn't a tree.

For two or more things:

There are / There aren't (are not)

There are trees.

Speaking Tip

Use short forms when you speak.

is not = isn't

are not = aren't

There ***isn't*** a road.

There Is:

There is always followed by a singular noun - For one thing.

- There is a book on the table.
Refers to one book.
- There is an apple in the basket.
Refers to one apple

Negative (using "isn't"):

- There isn't a pen in my bag.
(Means no single pen is present.)
- There isn't any milk left.
(Milk is an uncountable noun, so we treat it as singular.)

There are:

There are always followed by a plural noun - For two or more things.

- There are three chairs in the room.
Refers to multiple chairs.
- There are many flowers in the garden.
Refers to a large number of flowers.

Negative (using "aren't"):

- There aren't any eggs in the fridge.
(Means no eggs are present.)
- There aren't many students in the library today.
(Refers to a small number of students.)

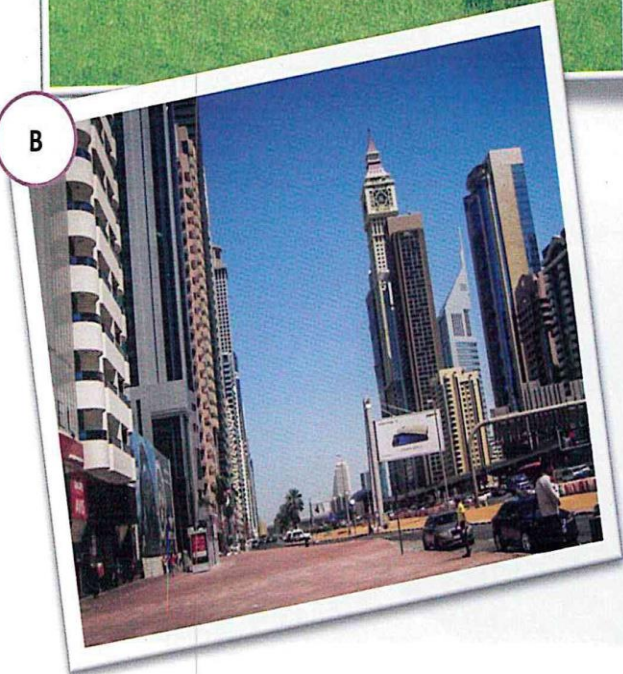
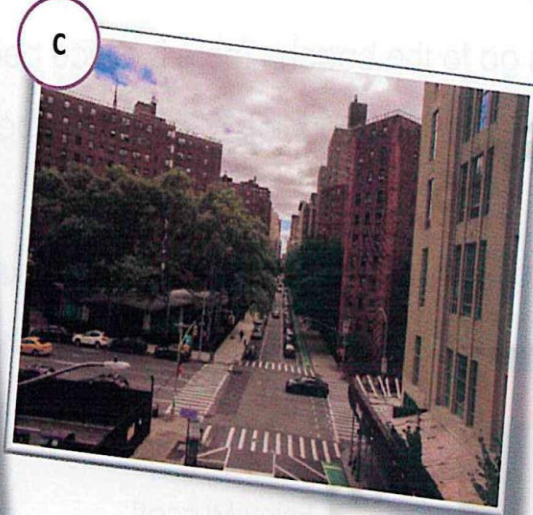
