There are different types of adverbs. Adverbs of manner give us extra information about how something happens.

I read quietly.

I speak English well.

You can make adverbs by adding -ly to the end of most adjectives.

#### 1. Adverbs of Manner:

 provide extra detail about the way an action happens. They usually answer the question "How?"

The most common way to form an adverb of manner is by adding -ly to the end of an adjective

Adjective Adverb of Manner

Quick quickly

careful carefully

quiet quietly

**Examples:** 

Sentence Verb (Action) Adverb of Manner (How?)

She runs quickly. runs quickly

He sings loudly. sings loudly

They work carefully. work carefully
