Plants are living things. They need water, sunlight, and air to grow. Most plants grow in the ground. Their roots go deep into the soil. Roots take in water and help keep the plant in place.

The stem is the part of the plant that grows above the ground. It holds the plant up and moves water from the roots to the leaves. Leaves use sunlight and air to make food for the plant. This is called photosynthesis.
