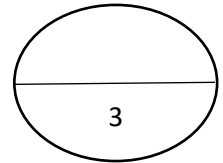
Part One:

Part Two: Create a plan to write about your favourite film. You need to write about the following points.

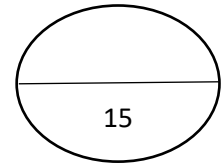
- 1- What is the name of your favourite film? Why do you like it?

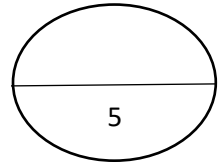


My Favourite Film
