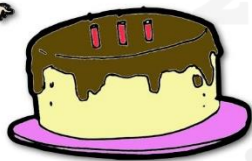

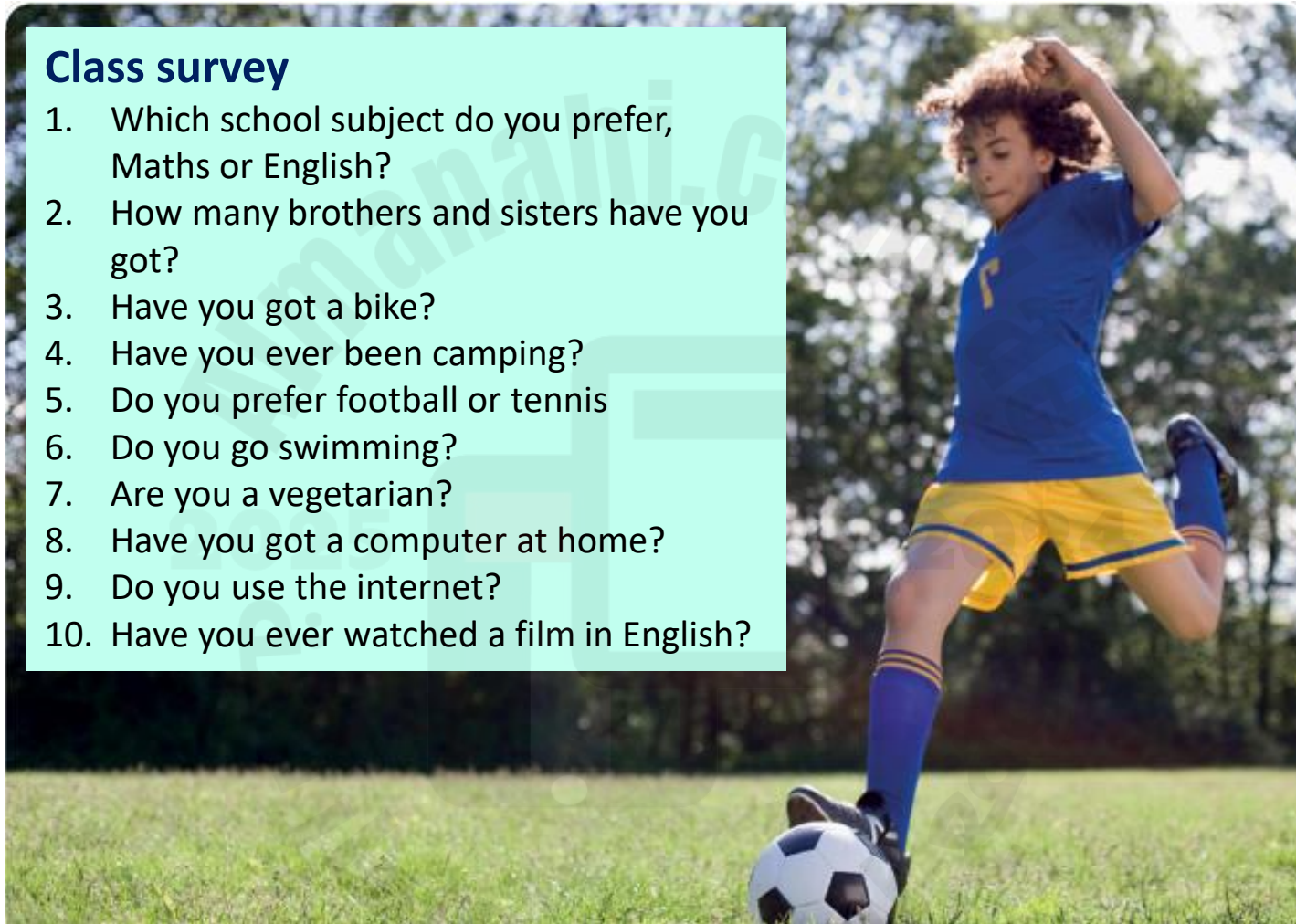

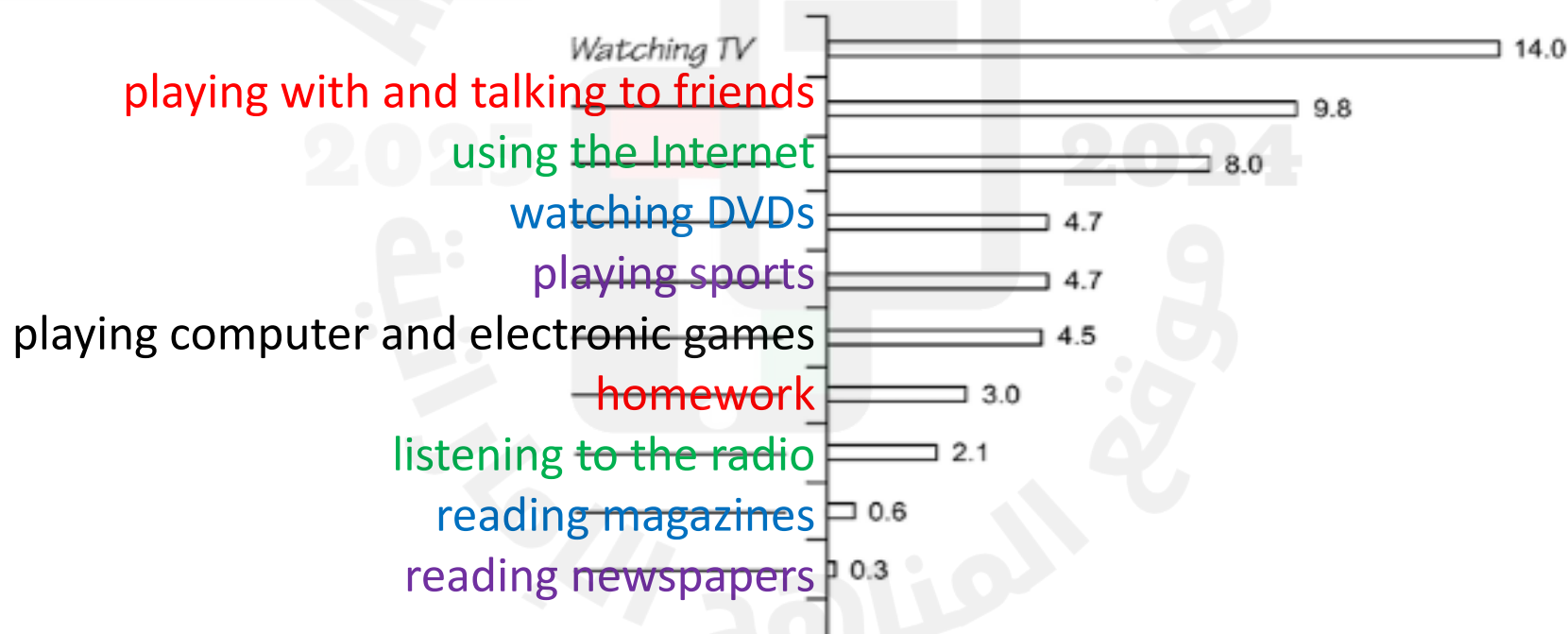

A recent survey has found that young Australians, aged 6 to 13, spend less time watching TV than they did three years ago. However, they still spend about 14 hours a week watching television, which means that it continues to be the most popular leisure activity.

Other leisure activities include playing with, and talking to friends (9.8 hours per week)

spend 4.7 hours a week watching DVDs and the same amount of time playing sports (4.7 hours). They spend almost the same amount of time playing computer and electronic games. Homework takes up 3 hours a week. They don't spend as much time reading magazines as listening to the radio. Reading newspapers is the least popular activity.



## Use of English: Expressions of quantity followed by of

It's important to know when to use *of* after expressions of quantity.

- use *of*:

a quarter of

*About a quarter **of** the class voted for football.*

**OF+ fractions/ per cent**

ninety per cent of

*Over ninety per cent **of** us have brown eyes.*

two-thirds of

*Two-thirds **of** the class come to school by car.*

- *of* is optional:

half (of)

*Half (**of**) the class voted for English as their favourite subject.*

**Half/ All + of**  
**Half/ All +~~of~~**

all (of)

*All (**of**) the students in our group voted for blue as their favourite colour.*

- *most* without *of*:

*most*

*Most students use the Internet.*

- *most* with *of*:

*most of*

### Did you know?

Here's how you can convert the results of a survey into percentages. If 9 out of 25 students voted for Maths in Question 1:

$$100 \div 25 = 4$$

$$9 \times 4 = 36$$

So, 36% of students said they preferred Maths.
