



3. Writing the Body Paragraphs	Explain and support your ideas	Write 2–3 paragraphs. Each paragraph has one idea. Use examples and linking words. "First, sports keep us healthy because they help us exercise regularly."
4. Writing the Conclusion	End your essay	Restate the main idea. Summarize points and end strongly. "In conclusion, playing sports helps students stay fit and learn cooperation."
5. Revising and Editing	Check your work	Fix grammar and spelling. Make sure ideas are clear and connected. Read it out loud.
