Too much/many; not enough
There are **too many** buttons.

Vocabulary

to fit, size, online, accessories, design, hundreds of

Meaning of vocabulary:

- **To fit:** to be the right size or shape.
- **Size:** how big or small something is.
- **Online:** using the internet.
- **Accessories:** extra items like bags, belts, or jewelry.
- **Design:** the way something looks.
- **Hundreds of:** a large number of something.

1. More than the right amount:

Too many

Saif: There are too many people.

2. Less than the right amount:

Not enough

Fatima: There is not enough space.

Amy: There are not enough sports shops.

too much/too many/not enough

We can use *too much/many* to say something is more than we like. We can use *not enough* to say something is less than the right amount.

We use different words with countable and uncountable nouns:

countable plural nouns:

there are too many
 not enough

uncountable nouns:

there is too much
 not enough

TOO MUCH / TOO MANY / NOT ENOUGH

These expressions are used to describe quantities—when there is:

Too much: More than necessary or wanted (negative meaning)

Too many: More than necessary or wanted (negative meaning)

Not enough: Less than necessary or wanted (negative meaning)

Countable Nouns (Plural):

Countable nouns are things you can count individually.

Examples:

Apples	Shirts
Bags	People

We use:

- There are too many + countable nouns
Ex. There are too many people in the shop.
- There are not enough + countable nouns
Ex. There are not enough chairs in the room.

Uncountable Nouns:

Uncountable nouns are things you cannot count individually. They often refer to mass or abstract ideas.

Examples:

Water	Time
Space	Money

We use:

- There is too much + uncountable noun
Ex. There is too much traffic today.
- There is not enough + uncountable noun
Ex. There is not enough time to finish the test.

Common Mistakes:

- There is too many people.
- There are too many people. (people = countable)
- There are too much traffic.
- There is too much traffic. (traffic = uncountable)
