Part 1: Vocabulary

Part 2: Main Steps to Write an Invitation Email

The key to a good invitation email is being clear and concise while sounding friendly. Follow these simple steps.

Step 1: The Subject Line (عنوان الرسالة)

- **Purpose:** Tell the recipient exactly what the email is about, immediately.
- **Examples:** "Hello," "Invitation to the Food Festival," "Want to join me on Saturday?"

Step 2: The Greeting (التحية)

- **Purpose:** Start the email with a friendly tone.
- **Examples:** "Hello [Name]," "Hi [Name]," "Dear [Name],"

Step 3: Friendly Opening (الافتتاحية)

- **Purpose:** A quick social check-in.
- **Examples:** "How are you?" "I hope you are well."

Step 4: State Your Purpose & Activity (الهدف والنشاط)

- **Purpose:** Say *what* you are planning to do and *when*. Refer to the festival name and date.
- **Lesson Example:** "I'm going to a Japanese food festival on Saturday with my family..."

Step 5: The Invitation & Key Details (الدعوة والتفاصيل)

- **Purpose:** Clearly ask them to come and provide crucial information (time, place, special notes).
- **Invitation Starters:**
 - "Would you like to come with us?"
 - "Do you want to join me?"
 - "Do you have time to..."
- **Add Details:** "...It will be really fun, and we can try lots of unusual foods. It starts at 9 am, but we are meeting at 10 am." Mention if tickets are needed.

Step 6: Call to Action / Closing Request (طلب الرد)

- **Purpose:** Politely ask for a reply so you can plan.
- **Examples:** "Please let me know if you can come." "Let me know your thoughts."
"RSVP by [date]."

Step 7: The Sign-off (الخاتمة)

- **Purpose:** End the email warmly.
- **Examples:** "Your friend," "Best regards," "Talk soon,"

Step 8: Your Name (الاسم)

- Print your name clearly.

To summarize the steps :

1. **Subject Line:** Write what the email is about (e.g., *Invitation to the Food Festival*).
2. **Greeting:** Start with "Hello" or "Hi" and the person's name.
3. **Opening:** Ask "How are you?"
4. **The Invitation:** State the name of the festival, the day, and the time.
5. **The Details:** Tell them why it will be fun (e.g., *We can try unusual food*).
6. **Action:** Ask them to reply (e.g., *Let me know if you can come*).
7. **Closing:** Write "Your friend," then your name.

- JOIN** Come along with friends.
- UNUSUAL** Special or different.
- INTERNATIONAL** From many countries.
- MEET** See someone at a place.
- TRY/TASTE** Eat a small amount.
- DELICIOUS** Very good food.
- TOGETHER** With other people.
- FUN** Enjoyable time.
- DATE** The day of the event.
- PLACE** The location.
- BRING** Carry along with you.
- CHEAP** Low cost.

YOUR WRITING STEPS

- START FRIENDLY & CHAT!**
Write "Hello [Name]," Ask "How are you?"
Example: Hello Aisha, How are you?
- INVITE & GIVE THE DETAILS!**
State the festival name and date.
ASK: "Do you want to come/join me?"
List key details:
WHEN?
WHERE?
COST?
WHAT? (like food!)
- CLOSE & SIGN OFF!**
Ask for a reply: "Please let me know if you can come."
End with "Your friend, [Your Name]."

- Closing Sentence:** Summarize why these events are meaningful for the community.

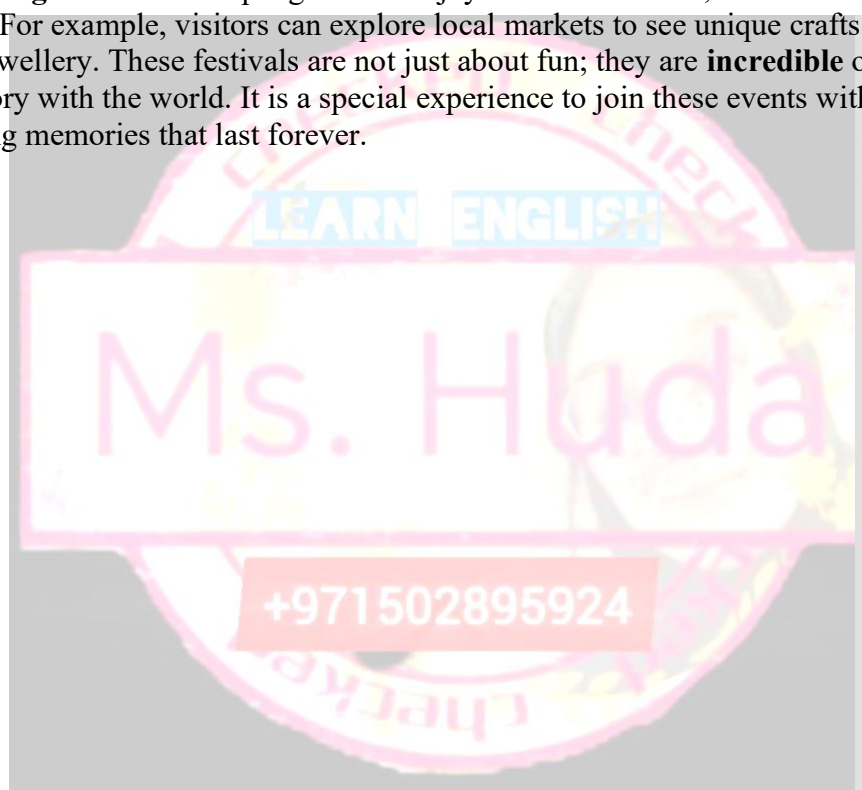

5 KEY PARAGRAPH STEPS

- #### 1 TOPIC SENTENCE (Main Idea)

Introduce the celebration and how great it is.
"UAE National Day is a magnificent festival."
- #### 2 ADD DESCRIPTIVE DETAILS (Sensory Words)

Describe what people hear, and feel.
"What do you see?" (Lights, Fireworks)
"What do you hear?" (Music, Cheering)
"How does it feel?" (Happy, Proud)
- #### 3 USE STRONG ADJECTIVES (Vocab!)

Incorporate words like amazing, breathtaking, wonderful.
Try to say: A breathtaking show, amazing food.
- #### 4 TALK ABOUT ACTIVITIES

Explain what people do (dance, eat, shop).
- #### 5 CONCLUDING SENTENCE (Final Thought)

Repeat the main idea or give a recommendation.
"This is a truly incredible celebration for everyone."
