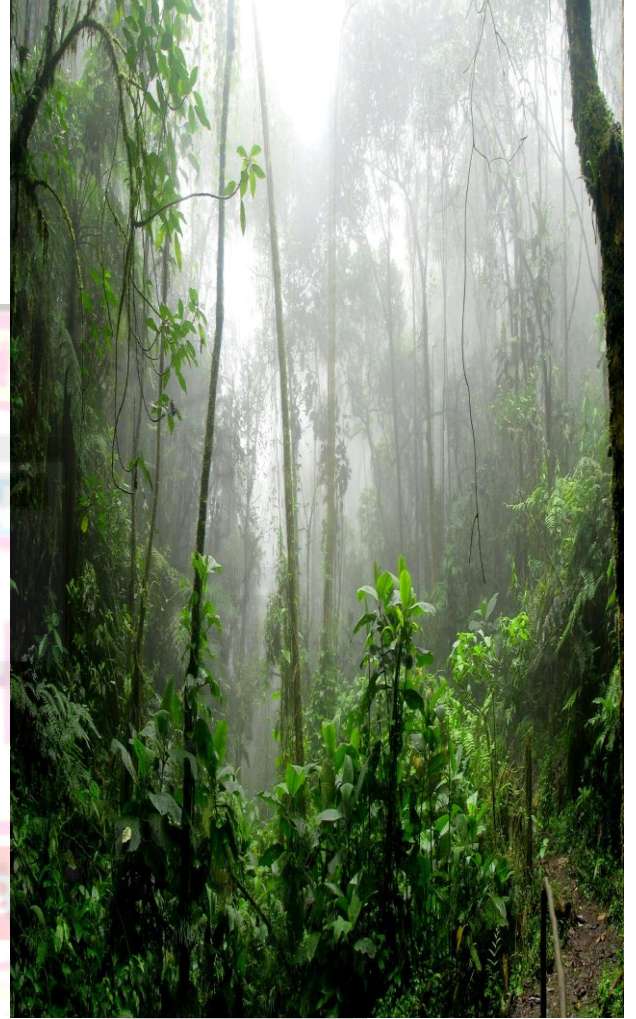

## Reading

The natural world is a complex  
System where every part matters.



Areas like the rainforest are often called the "lungs of the planet" because they help keep our air clean. These forests are essential to human health; a high percent of the world's medicine is discovered within their plants. However, as humans use more land for buildings and farms, these habitats are putting many species in danger.

In the United Arab Emirates, conservation is a top priority. In the past, animals like the Arabian oryx and the Arabian leopard faced a high risk of extinction due to hunting and habitat loss. Recognizing this danger, the late Sheikh Zayed started a conservation programme in Al Ain to save the oryx. He knew that to have a healthy ecosystem, we must work to protect the wildlife that lives there.

Because of these successful programmes, the oryx were moved to protected areas like Sir Bani Yas Island. Today, there are around 6,200 Arabian oryx in the UAE, which is the largest number in the world. This shows that when we take action to save nature, the environment can recover. We must



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continue to value our land and animals to ensure the air remains clean and the planet stays healthy for everyone.
