### Vocabulary

picnic, candle, matches,  
bar, loaf, slice, packet, jar,

## Meaning of vocabulary:

- **Picnic:** A meal eaten outdoors, usually in a park or countryside.
- **candle:** A stick of wax with a wick that you light to produce light.
- **Matches:** Small sticks that produce fire when struck against a rough surface.
- **Bar:** A solid block of something (e.g., a bar of chocolate or soap).
- **Loaf:** A shaped piece of bread.
- **Slice:** A thin, flat piece cut from something (a slice of cake or bread).
- **Packet:** A small bag or container (a packet of crisps or biscuits).
- **Jar:** A glass container with a lid, used for food (e.g., a jar of jam).
- **Can:** metal container (usually cylindrical), used for drinks or food (a can of soda).
- **Box:** A container, often made of cardboard or plastic, used to store things.

## WHAT ARE QUANTIFIERS?









### Quantifiers help us talk about:

- Uncountable nouns** (like water, yogurt, rice, chocolate, etc.)
- Grouped items** (like bananas, flowers, biscuits)

**We can't say one chocolate or two waters that's why we use:**

- A bar of chocolate
- A bottle of water

-  Soda can → A can of cola
-  Crisp bag → A bag of crisps
-  Olives in jar → A jar of olives

-  Chocolate → A bar of chocolate
-  Bread → A loaf of bread
-  Cake slice → A slice of cake
-  Flowers → A bunch of flowers
-  Bananas → A bunch of bananas
-  Matches → A box of matches
-  Yoghurt pot → A pot of yoghurt
-  Water bottle → A bottle of water
