## The Maiden Voyage of the *Titanic*

In April 1912, a magnificent new ship was preparing for its very first trip. Its name was the *Titanic*, and people from all over the world were talking about it. It was the largest ship that had ever been built, and it was considered a true marvel. Many said it was so strong that it could never *sink*!

The *Titanic* was not just an ordinary boat; it was designed for exploring the great, vast *seas*. On a sunny day, it set off from the United Kingdom to travel to New York. Its crew and many excited *passengers* were ready for a spectacular journey. It was a very fast ship, too, the speediest of its time.

A few days later, on a chilly night, the moon was invisible, and the sea was very quiet. But danger was hiding in the darkness. For the next three hours, the grand ship struggled. Finally, it broke in half and sank down to the bottom of the deep ocean. Sadly, more than 1500 people lost their lives in the cold water. It was a day that people around the world would never forget.

In the morning, the newspaper headlines carried the tragic news: "The Sinking of *Titanic*." It was a huge *headline* that the world had to see. People everywhere read the story in their daily *newspaper*, feeling sad and shocked.

For many, many years, the *wreck* (the remains) of the *Titanic* stayed hidden on the ocean floor, four kilometers below the surface. Nobody knew exactly where it was. Then, in 1985, an *explorer* was finally able to find it! It was a huge discovery! The explorer used a special robot with a camera to take pictures of the ship. They even found many objects that belonged to the people on board.

This sad and incredible story teaches us that even the greatest, fastest, and biggest ships are not invincible. It's a powerful story that reminds us of a dark day in history, but also of the remarkable curiosity of explorers who still search for answers about our world today.
