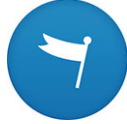

Show the argument and the encounter argument, using a word or a phrase of contrast like; In contrast, However, But, ,whereasetc.

Write a thesis statement.

Main Body: Write two body paragraphs;

Paragraph 2: Write and focus on the **advantages (pros)** of the issue.

Give facts, examples & details to support this argument.

Use words and phrases of sequencing like; Firstly, , Secondly, ... Thirdly, etc.

Paragraph 3: Write and focus on the **disadvantages (cons)** of the issue.

Give facts, examples & details to support this argument.

Use words and phrases of sequencing like; To begin with = To start with, In addition to that, Added to that,..... . Furthermore,..... . Moreover,..... etc.

Conclusion: Paragraph 4:

Summarise the main points and restate the thesis statement.

Provide a final opinion, thought or a suggestion to the topic.
