Price

- There is a **big difference in price** between the two products, as product 1, which costs \$180 is **much cheaper** than product 2, which costs \$ 265.
- There is a **big difference in price** between the two products, as product 2, which costs \$265, is **much more expensive** than product 1, which costs \$ 180.
- There is a **slight difference in price** between the two products, as product 1, which costs \$180, is **slightly cheaper** than product 2, which costs \$ 190.
- There is a **slight difference in price** between the two products, as product 2, which costs \$190, is **slightly more expensive** than product 1, which costs \$ 180.
- Both **products** are the same price, which is BD150.
- There is not such a big difference in price between the two products. Product 1 is/costs BD250 and product 2 is/costs BD255.

Size/Weight

- Product 1 which weighs 170g is **slightly/much lighter/heavier** than product 2 with its weight of 185g.
- There is not such a big difference in size between the two products. Product 1 is 7 inches whereas product 2 is 6.5 inches.
- The two products are similar in length, but not in weight. Product 1 weighs just 14.1 kg, whereas product 2 weighs 16.4 kg.

Colour

Product 1 comes in three colours, which are black, metallic silver and red, while product 2 is available in black, white and grey.

Shape

- The two products are completely different in shape. Product 1 is **curved/streamlined/circular/angular/ rectangular**. However, product 2 is **curved/streamlined/circular/angular/ rectangular**.
- The two products are the same in shape. They are both **curved/streamlined/circular/angular/ rectangular**.

Design

Although both products are **attractive/modern/stylish/retro/vintage(old-fashioned)/classic/elegant/ innovative / artistic**, product 1 is rated as 5-star, whereas product 2 as 3-star.

Durability

Product 1 is well made. However, the headband is thin and might wear out quickly. The cable may be a bit weak as well. In contrast, product 2 is well built and has a strong construction. It is made to last for a long time. The headband is made of flexible plastic wrapped in soft leather. It also has a strong cable.

RAM and Storage

There is a significant difference between the two products when it comes to RAMS and storage. Product 1 has 8 GB RAM, and 256 GB memory capacity. Product 2 has only 3 GB RAM and a memory capacity of 128 GB.

Camera

Product 1 has a better-quality camera than that of Product 2, as Product 1's camera is 16 megapixels, whereas Product 2's camera is only 12 megapixels.

Battery life

Product 1's battery lasts for 10 hours, which is longer than product 2's battery, which lasts for only 6 hours.

Resolution

There is a very big difference in resolution between the two products, as the resolution of product 1 is 45.7MP, which is **higher/much better** than that of product 2 with its resolution of 30.3MP.

Processor

Product 1 is faster with itsprocessor than product 2 with its processor.

Applications

Product 1 has a variety of applications available in the play store for free, whereas product 2 has only some free applications in the store.

Conclusion and recommendation

To sum up, the comparison shows that both (products) are well made and are good value for money. However, I can safely recommend (product 1) to be used in the company because it has much better features than (product 2) and greatly exceeds it although it is more expensive.

Price and weight

Apple iPad Pro is more expensive than Samsung Galaxy S7, as Apple iPad costs BD 350, whereas Samsung Galaxy costs only BD 320. **As for weight**, Samsung Galaxy S7, **which weighs 0.86 pounds**, is slightly lighter than Apple iPad Pro, with its weight of 0.96 pounds.

Design

Both Tablets are attractive, stylish and polished with a professional look, but Samsung Galaxy S7 is thinner and lighter with a plastic back, whereas Apple iPad Pro is longer and wider with strong aluminum back. **As for resolution**, Samsung Galaxy S7 has higher resolution than Apple iPad Pro.

RAM and storage

Both Tablets have 8 GB RAM, but they have different memory capacities as Apple tab Pro has three types; 64 GB, 128 GB and 256 GB, whereas Samsung Galaxy S7 has only two memory capacities: 64 GB and 256 GB.

Camera and battery

Samsung Galaxy Tab S7 has a better camera than that of Apple iPad Pro, as Galaxy's cam is 16 megapixels, whereas Apple's camera is only 12 megapixels. As for the battery life, the Apple iPad Pro battery lasts longer than the Samsung Galaxy battery; Apple iPad battery lasts for 10 hours and 42 minutes, whereas the Samsung battery lasts for only 9 hours and 12 minutes.

Durability and applications

Apple iPad pro is well-built with strong construction, but Samsung Galaxy tab S7 is well-made. **Yet**, it can be broken easily which means that Apple iPad is more durable than Samsung Galaxy tab S7. In addition, Samsung Galaxy tab S7 has a variety of applications available in the play store for free, whereas Apple iPad Pro has only some free applications in the store.

Conclusion and recommendation

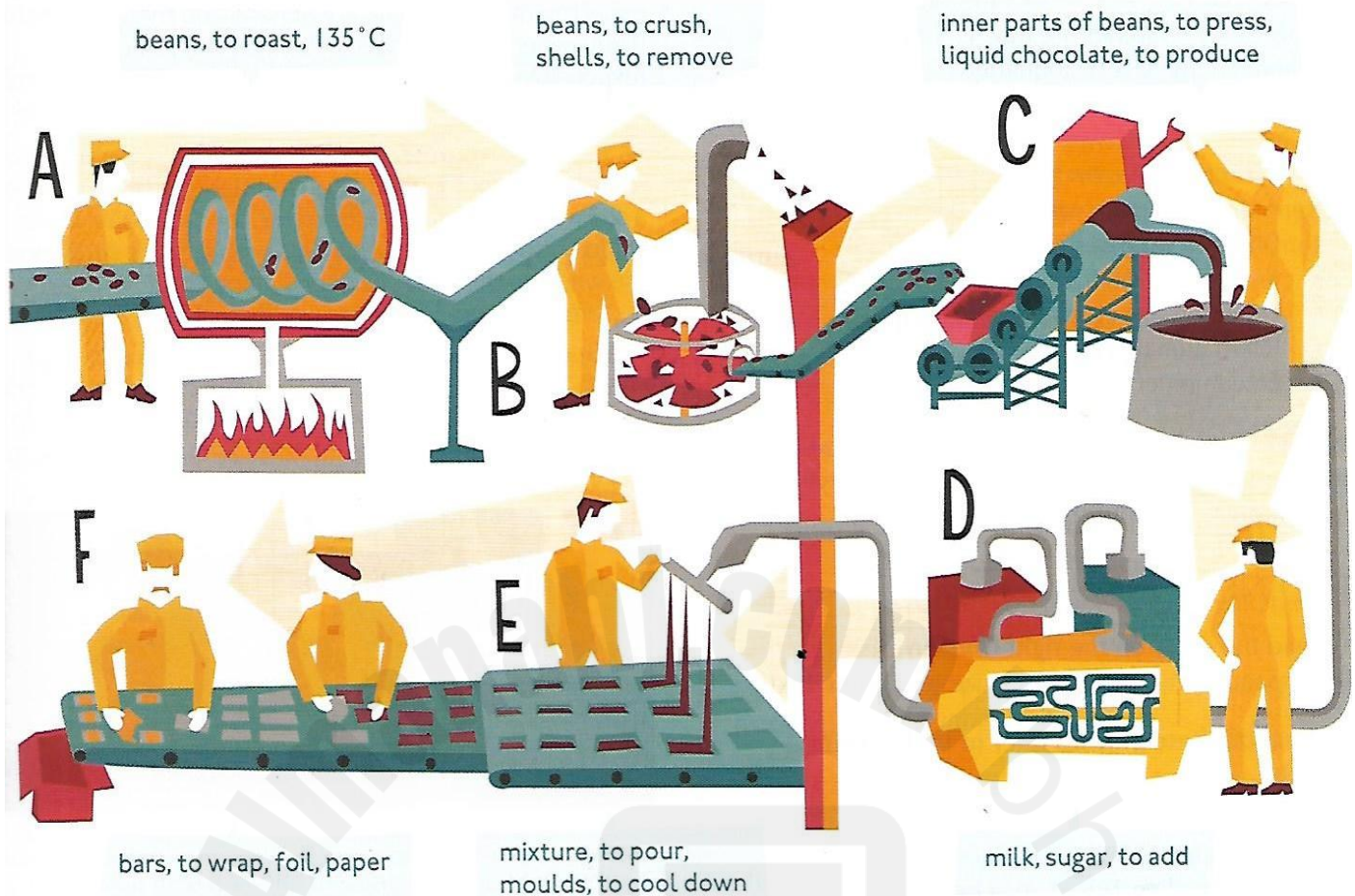

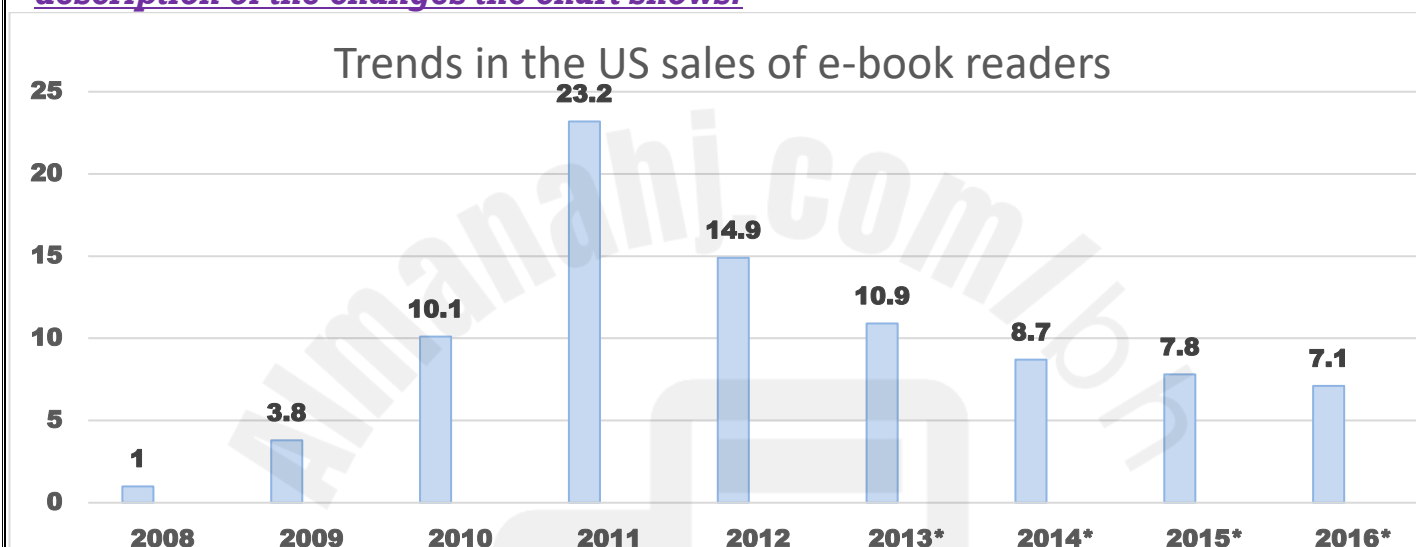

Look at the chart below showing trends in US sales of e-book readers. Write a description of the changes the chart shows.



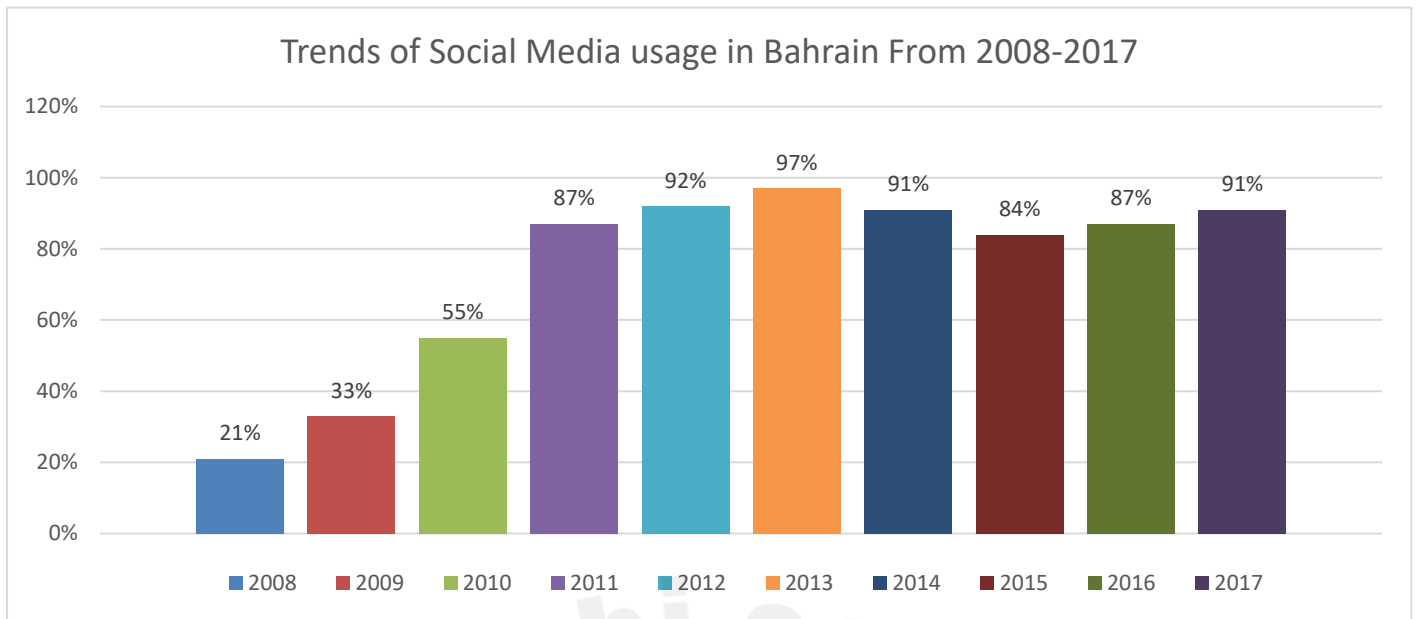
This chart shows the results of a study carried out for the Publishing Industry Association into trends in the US sales of e-book readers over a period of 8 years between 2008 and 2016. The horizontal axis includes the periods (years) whereas the vertical axis refers to shipments in million units.

Overall, it is clear that after reaching the peak in 2011 the number of the sales of e-books has been falling. The sales in 2011 were more than the sales in the three years between 2014 and 2016.

Between 2011 and 2012 the number of e-book sales decreased gradually to 14.9 million books. From 2012 to 2013, there was a slight decline in the sales to reach 10.9 million books. The decrease continued gradually in 2014 to reach 8.7 million books. There was a slight constant fall in 2015 and 2016 to 7.8 million and 7.1 million books.

In summary, the sales of e-books in US has a gradual increase from 2008 to reach the peak in 2011 but it has a gradual decrease from 2012 to get the greatest fall in 2016.
