Write a summary

You can organise your summary in the following way:

- 1-Begin with an introductory statement that gives the title of the text and author's name (if known).
- 2-Add the overall main idea of the text. You can also mention the author's purpose if you know or can infer it.
- 3-Add a new sentence for each main point in the text. Include the main supporting details, either in the same sentence or in a new sentence.
- 4-Finish with a concluding sentence that restates the overall main point.
