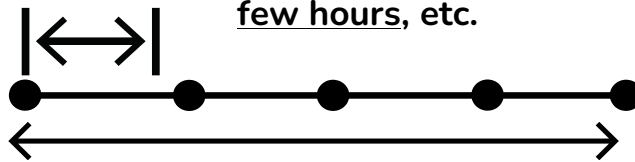
# Present Perfect (for \ since)

## -Read and learn

We use present perfect *with (for)* to talk about length of time.

نستخدم كلمة ( *for* ) للتحدث عن مدة من الزمن.

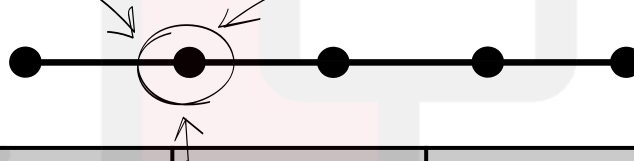
We use *for* + a period of time, e.g. *for two weeks*, *for ten years*, *for ten days*, *for a few hours*, etc.

We use present perfect *with (since)* to talk about point in time.

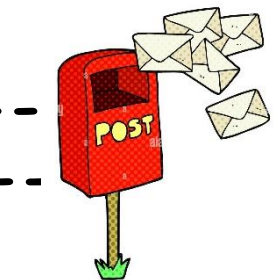

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
