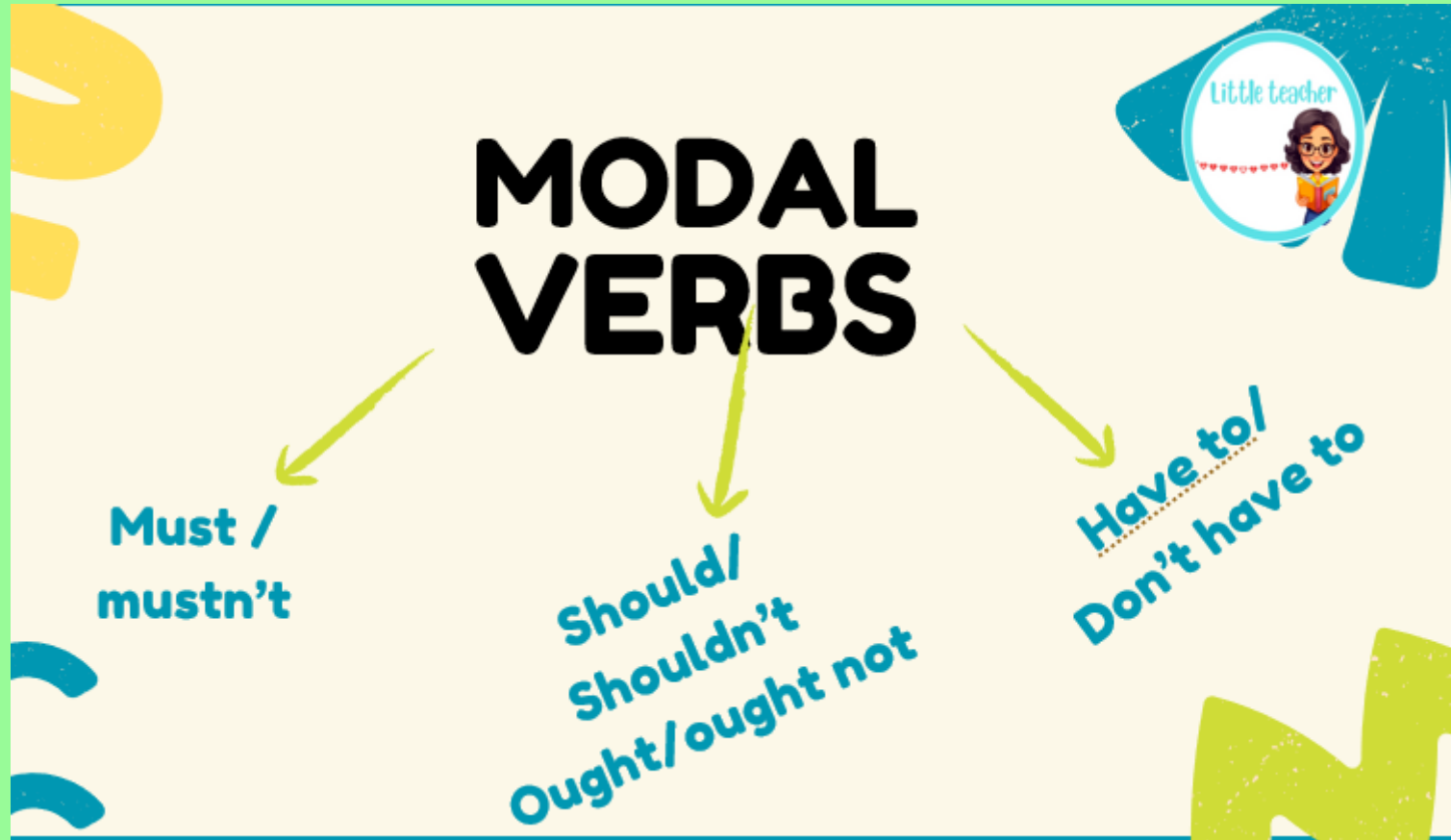

• You **have to** wear a helmet when you go rock climbing



• You **don't have to** wear a helmet when you play tennis.



Advice

We use **should/shouldn't** and **ought to /ought not to** for advice.

1-You **should** see a doctor if you feel sick.



We use **shouldn't** to mean it's a **bad** idea to do something.

2-You **shouldn't** go to bed late.

3-Beginners **ought to** take climbing lessons.

4-They **ought not to** climb difficult routes.



Necessity

We use **must** to express necessity.

1-You **must** do your homework.

We also use **must** to talk about a rule or law.

2-You **must** wear a school uniform.
