The Fastest Animal on Land

Cheetahs are one of the most fascinating animals in the world. They live in grasslands and open plains in Africa. These big cats are easy to recognise because of their long, thin bodies, small heads, and black spots on golden fur. But what really makes them special is their speed.

A cheetah can run faster than any other land animal — up to 110 kilometres per hour! They use this speed to catch animals like gazelles. However, they can only run fast for a few seconds before they need to rest.

Cheetahs are built for running. They have long legs, strong muscles, and special claws that help them grip the ground. Their tails act like steering wheels to help them change direction quickly while chasing prey.


