- Woman: Well, he's a father now, you know. But he's not bringing the baby with him.
- Man: Oh, what a pity!

4. What will Ruby do tonight?

Girl: Mum, Kate's just phoned.

Woman: Uhmmm...

Girl: She wants me to go to the cinema this evening.

Woman: You can't go out, Ruby!

Girl: Why?? Mum!!

Woman: If you haven't finished your school work, you can't go out.

Girl: But I have!

Woman: Oh, did you!

Girl: And I've even cleaned my shoes.

Woman: That's all right then, but don't be late!

5. How much did the woman's desk cost?

Man: I've just spent sixty pounds fifty pence on a new desk. Very expensive!

Woman: Well, I paid sixty-six pounds fifty pence for mine. So your deal is better than mine!
