#### **suggested essay (basketball)**

Before the 1900s, there were no special basketball uniforms. Basketball players wore any type of athletic clothes which made it difficult to differentiate teams. The first basketball uniform had knee-length padded pants or shorter pants with long tights. There were two types of T-shirts, one with sleeves, while the other was sleeveless. The entire uniform was made of heavy wool. They wore special basketball shoes with suction cups.

Basketball uniforms have changed through the years. Today they wear long shorts and sleeveless t-shirts. The uniform is made of lighter polyester and nylon. They wear sneakers, this keeps basketball players cool as they run or jump. Each team has its own colours now. For example, San Antonio Spurs players wear black and white t-shirts and shorts. In future, these uniforms will change too. Players need uniforms that are practical and in fashion.

### **Another suggested essay (Football)**

**Before 1870, there were no football uniforms. Players wore their own clothes, which made it hard to know which team they were on. The first football uniform had long, loose shorts. Players wore striped, formal shirts with collars and buttons. The entire uniform was made of a heavy fabric. Players also wore leather football boots.**

**Today, football uniforms are very different. Players wear shorts and T-shirts with names and numbers. The uniforms are made of light fabric. Each team now has a different colour.
