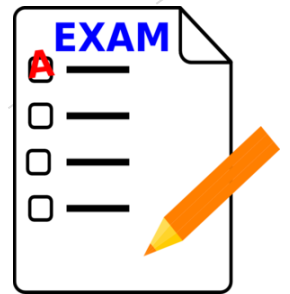

He also videos some scenes and uploads them on the Centre's YouTube channel. Mostly, he spends one hour underwater. He lectures the visitors of the centre and shows them the photos and the videos. My brother says, 'Although I have a tiring job, I still love it!'
