1- Writing option (1):

The writing should include the following:

- A subject line (1st line in the email that explains why the student is writing and what the email is about in a few interesting words)
- A greeting
- An opening
- A body (colours the student likes and connections he/she has to them and how they make her/him feel)
- A closing remark
- A sign-off

2- Writing option (2):

The writing should include the following:

- A formal greeting
- Facts, ideas and examples about how people waste water (at least 3 examples, or facts)
- An introductory sentence that explains what you are complaining about.
- At least two body paragraphs to talk about the causes of water waste.
- A concluding paragraph (show how the problem of water waste relates to the complaint)
- One or more suggestions of some practical ways to resolve the issue (optional)
- A paragraph thanking the manager for his/her attention and a sign-off

Writing (B): (20 Marks)

1- Writing option (1):

The writing should include the following:

- Clear and accurate usage of phrases used to express opinion and phrases used to state a fact.
 - When expressing opinion:
I believe.../ I think.../ It seems like...
 - When stating a fact:
In fact.../ For example,.../ research shows...
- A short introduction with a topic sentence that describes what the topic of the essay is.
- Two to three body paragraphs with each including (2- 3 opinions with fact(s) supporting each opinion)
- A concluding paragraph (expresses the student's overall opinion, or argument, in different words)

2- Writing option (2):

The writing should include the following:

- an introductory paragraph with a topic sentence that introduces the topic and the person or people student is writing about
- a couple of paragraphs to explain the setting, plot, conflict and climax
- the final paragraph will include the conclusion, or what happened in the end, and the message or point student wants to share about the story
