We are very proud of our national park and want you to enjoy it as much as possible. However, when you come to the park please remember that it is a valuable and sensitive natural environment and so must not be damaged in any way. Please follow the rules to ensure you have a safe and pleasant visit, and try to leave everything as you find it, as others have done previously.

When you plan your visit, pack everything you will need during your stay. There are no shops selling food and drink! You should also bring a set of basic tools if you are using mountain bikes, because the emergency service is not prepared to help people every time they have a flat tyre. Clear, up-to-date maps of the whole park, and a compass are needed. Someone in your group should know how to read maps and use compasses.

When you first arrive you must fill in a registration form and hand it in to the warden on duty. He will give you an emergency number to phone in case of accident, or if you find an injured animal or bird. You must only use this number when necessary, calls for less serious matters will result in a charge to be paid before leaving the park. You should know that we have the right to refuse entry to the park if exceptionally bad weather is forecast.

In the park, you may follow any of the paths and tracks marked with a blue or red sign, but the green and yellow signs are only for groups with guides. Please do not use private boats on ponds and lakes, there are official ones for that.

Obviously, no rubbish may be left anywhere: a warden seeing visitors dropping litter will escort them from the camp. Picnics are allowed, but do not give any food to any animals.

We look forward to welcoming you and your family and friends to our park, and hope you enjoy your stay.

Warden: a person responsible for the supervision of a particular place or activity or for enforcing the regulations associated with it / supervisor /guardian
