The average American household gets no (0) from three-quarters of the electricity they pay for. Since Americans (1) roughly \$350 billion on electricity each year, this is a shocking waste. But how does it happen? Today, most electricity (2) produced from fossil fuels (3) coal and gas, but two-thirds of the energy is lost in the form of heat (4) they're burnt at power plants. Also, around seven percent (5) electricity is wasted during its delivery to our homes.

This is called 'line loss' - and the longer the distance electricity has to travel, the (6) the line loss. What about waste in the home?
