5- Write a classification essay to describe two types of animal flight.

Flight is a trait that can be found in three types of animals: birds, insects, and bats.

While birds, insects and bats are the only animals that can fly, there are a number of animals that can glide. The colugo is one of them.

Bats are the only mammals that can fly. Their arms stretch out into webbed wings made up of a thin skin. To fly, they flap their spread-out fingers. The bat's wings are much thinner than a bird's feathery wings. They have more bones in them too. The bats use advanced navigation system while flying.

The colugo lives high up in trees and have flaps of skin between their legs, tail and neck. They can glide through the forest with their webbed limbs. They spend most of their time up in the trees hunting and protecting territory.

Although wings are important for flying, some animals can fly without wings. Just ask the Colugo! What other animals can fly without having wings?

6- Classifying Sailing Boats

People have sailed across the sea for years. Since then, there has been two main types of boats: sailing boats and motorboats.

Sailing boats use the force of wind. A sailing boat has a mast with sails. The number of sails depends on the size of the boat. The bigger the boat, the more sails it has. There is also a rudder for steering.

The boat speed is controlled by putting the sails up and down. Sailing boats can be big and heavy.

They can be made of metal and wood.

A motorboat uses an engine. The engine is installed at the end of the boat. The engine is usually used for steering. Motorboats are made of fiber because it is light and strong. The lighter the motorboat, the more efficient the engine will be.

If you want to sail quietly, you must consider travelling in sailing boats. They are relaxing, but not as fast as motorboats. Also, you would not have to worry about fuel. Have you ever heard about a ship running out of wind?

7- Flying Machines

Long time before planes, people had been experiencing different flying machines. We still use some of those flying machines. Some depend on air for movement, while others use engines.

Hot-air balloons and gliders use air currents for movement. Hot-air balloon pilots steer their aircraft by ascending or descending into air currents that move the balloon. The pilot controls the balloon's movement by heating the air inside the balloon, or by allowing it to cool. A glider also uses air currents to soar and glide. Small planes pull gliders along a runway to help them take off.

Their long wingspan and strong body give riders a safe, smooth flight. Hot-air balloons and gliders are most often used for fun and adventure.

Helicopters first appeared during World War II. A helicopter hasn't got wings, but, like a plane, it's got an engine that makes its blades spin at high speeds. This allows the helicopter to ascend into the sky. Unlike an aeroplane, helicopters can stay in one place in the sky for a long time. Today, helicopters are mostly used by medical teams and the military. But you can also take a helicopter ride for fun.

So before your next plane ride, remember that planes aren't the only way to fly. Which type of flying machine would you most like to travel in?
