Start assessing the written task by looking at the "Task Achievement" first and decide on the mark for that part before considering the other parts. If the task is irrelevant, students get no mark.

There are **two** parts in this listening exam. You must answer them both. You will hear each part twice. For each part of the exam, there will be time for you to look through the questions and time for you to check your answers.

Now look at Part 1

Listening: Part1

A- You will hear a conversation between a radio presenter and a woman. Listen and circle (T) for true sentences and circle (F) for false sentences.

You have two minutes to read the questions. [pause]

Now we are ready to start. Listen carefully.

Man: You're listening to Ask Vic - England's number one phone-in radio show. The phone lines are open, so give me a call on 555-2567. If you've got a problem and need some advice, I'm here for the next two hours. Oh, I see We've got our first caller. Hello, you're on the air.

Woman: Hi, Victor. My name's Pam. Over the years, I've heard you give advice to lots of people with phobias, so I was wondering if you could help me, too.

Man: I'll certainly try. What phobia do you suffer from?

Woman: OK, don't laugh, but I've got globophobia - a fear of balloons. My parents say it started on my first birthday, when a balloon popped in my face. I can't remember it, of course, but I must have got a terrible shock. Now, I can't even enter a room where there's one! And if I come across one by accident, I have a shortness of breath and feel extremely weak.

Man: But what do you do at parties?

Woman: I just avoid them. For example, last month it was my best friend's birthday, but I told her I was ill. Only family members know about my condition, you see.

Man: That's a shame. Basically, the treatment that works best for most phobias is exposure therapy. This involves facing the thing you're scared of little by little. So, in your case, on the first day, you might begin by looking at a picture of a balloon, then move on to a video of a balloon, then maybe a real balloon but from a distance. Eventually, you might be comfortable enough to touch one. In your case, it is better to get professional help.

Man: I'm sure it will. So, here's your passport, and your boarding pass. You're in seat 24A.

Woman: Thank you. And where does it say the gate?

Man: Right here. It's Gate 23.

Woman: Oh yes. Sorry about all the questions. It's just that it's my first foreign holiday, so, I'm a bit nervous.

Man: That's quite alright. I'm sure everything will go very smoothly.

Woman: One last thing... is this the boarding time here? 7:30?

Man: That's right. Have a pleasant flight!

Woman: I'm sure I will. Thank you!
