Every weekend, a 16-year-old girl, Amal, wakes up early to volunteer at a local animal shelter in her town. While most of her classmates sleep in or play video games, Amal spends her mornings feeding cats, cleaning cages, and helping with pet adoptions. "At first, I just wanted to add something useful to my college application," she says. "But now, it's something I truly enjoy."

Volunteering, which is an act of an individual or group giving their time and effort for community service, is becoming more popular among teenagers around the world. According to a recent study by Youth Global, nearly 40% of teenagers between the ages of 14 and 18 take part in some form of community service. They work in hospitals, help clean public parks, support the elderly, or join environmental projects.

Experts believe volunteering can have a positive impact on teenagers. It teaches responsibility, builds teamwork, and helps young people develop empathy. **It** also allows them to explore future careers or personal interests. "When teens volunteer, they see the world beyond themselves," says community organiser Daniel Kwame.

However, not everyone agrees. Some students complain that they are forced to do community service just to graduate. Others say it adds stress to an already busy schedule of schoolwork, exams, and family **duties**. Despite these challenges, many young volunteers say the experience is worth it. Amal explains, "It's hard work, but seeing a cat find a new home makes me happy."

In many countries, schools and youth organisations are now encouraging students to take part in voluntary service programmes. To improve voluntary work, many organisations support students based on their goals, interests and schedules. Therefore, volunteering is not just for improving students' experience, but also for building stronger and more caring communities.
