Read the following passage carefully, then answer the questions that follow:

Every school has a science lab where students can enjoy science. Mr. Hamad is a science teacher who loves science. He wants his students to love it too. He believes that safety is important in a science lab.

In Mr. Hamad's lab, experiments could include dangerous materials, so following safety rules is needed to avoid accidents and injuries. As soon as the students get into the lab, he makes sure they know what to do and how to stay safe. He starts with a smile, handing out safety goggles. Next, he asks students to wear lab coats to keep clothes **clean** and tidy.

It is important for students to listen carefully to their teacher's instructions before they start experiments. Mr. Hamad usually tells students what to do step by step. They should never taste or eat anything in the lab because some materials might be dangerous. Students should also remember, if they spill something, they should tell Mr. Hamad right away so he can help clean it up safely. They shouldn't run or play in the lab because it is a place for learning and discovery, not for running races. By following these rules, students can have lots of fun exploring and learning in the science lab while staying safe.
