Have you ever wondered how ice cream was first made? Centuries ago, people in ancient China mixed snow with milk and rice to create a cold, sweet dessert enjoyed only by the wealthy who could pay for making it. Later, travellers and traders carried the idea to the Middle East, Africa and Europe. By the 1600s, the rich families in Italy and France were serving early types of ice cream at their parties. However, ice cream was expensive and rare because it needed ice, which had to be stored underground to keep it cold or brought from mountains during the winter. Only the rich could manage to enjoy it.

In the 1800s, an American woman named Nancy Johnson invented a simple ice cream freezer which worked by hand. Her clever invention made it easier to mix and freeze the cream smoothly without using natural ice. Thanks to her idea, ice cream became popular across the United States. Sellers began selling it in small cups on city streets, and families enjoyed making it at home during warm summer days.

In 1904, during the World's Day Festival in Saint Louis, a man who sold biscuits did not have enough cups for ice cream. Thinking quickly, he rolled up a biscuit to hold the cold dessert. People loved the idea and that's how the ice cream cone was born! Since then, ice cream has come in different tastes, from classic vanilla and chocolate to unusual ones like corn.
