So, what did camels carry that made this **risky** journey worth it? It was salt. For years, salt was worth its weight in gold in West Africa; it was called "The White Gold".



The Kingdom of Mali was one of the richest countries in the 13<sup>th</sup> century because it traded salt for gold. In ancient Mali, people would dig up large holes in mines to get the salt blocks and carry **them** across the Sahara Desert using camels. The salt was transported to cities like Gao and Djenne, where it was exchanged for other valuable goods like gold and silver.

The Kingdom of Ghana, was a another very rich county in West Africa because of salt trading. The king of Ghana controlled most of the trading roads and protected the traders and their camels from dangers by special policemen. Ghana was the center and the network of salt trading. It connected West Africa, North Africa, European countries, and the Middle East in salt trade. This made Ghana a very lively country.
