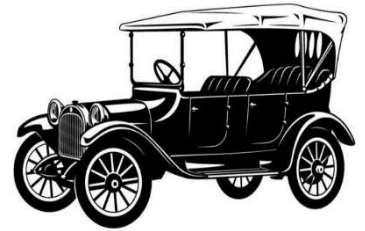

The first car was built in the late 19th century. In 1886, Karl Benz created a three-wheeled vehicle powered by a gasoline engine. It was very simple and slow, but it marked the beginning of a new age in transportation. At first, cars were expensive and only rich people could buy them. In the early 20th century, Henry Ford changed everything. In 1908, he introduced a Model T car **which** was cheaper and easier to make because of the assembly line. It allowed more people to own cars, and soon, cars became common in many countries.



Over the years, cars became faster, safer, and more comfortable. New inventions like seat belts, air conditioning, and radios made driving easier and more enjoyable. Later, computers and GPS systems were added to help drivers. Cars have greatly changed from the slow three-wheeled invention of Karl Benz to the smart, eco-friendly vehicles of today.

In the future, cars will be even smarter and safer than today. They will use clean energy, like electricity and hydrogen, to **protect** the planet. Many cars will be fully self-driving and will not need a human driver. Passengers will be able to read, rest, or watch movies while the car drives.
