If you're feeling down or mentally tired, your phone which is probably always on and in your hand might be the problem. A new study has linked feelings of worry, anger, and depression with growing use of smartphones and other devices.

As smart as phones may be these days, teens basically don't know when to stop. To protect your mental health, experts say you must develop ways of diminishing their usage. This involves limiting notification, deleting some applications, or simply turning smartphones off.

Jean Twenge, psychology professor, San Diego university, released a study that showed that we touch them about 250 times a day on average. The study revealed that teens' feelings of sadness and negative thoughts had gone up by 12 per cent between 2010 and 2017. Nearly half of the teens who spend five or more hours a day on a smartphone have mixed feelings of anger and sadness compared to 28% of those who spend less than an hour a day on a device.

Health experts confirmed they are seeing a rise in signs of depression and worry among teens. They also say that the best way to fight this is to discuss healthy ways to use smartphones. When your parents were at school, they could go out with their friends during the day, and they would relax with their family at night. There was balance. But smartphones do not give that break. Besides, the continuous fear of missing out, or the need to feel included, keeps teens connected.
