Three hundred years ago an Englishman made the first diving machine, and two hundred years ago an American made the first submarine. Today machines can dive deeper and stay underwater longer. Thirty years ago, a small American submarine dived 11,000 metres under the sea.

Astronauts explore space in spaceships; oceanauts explore the sea and its floor in submarines. Oceanauts are brave scientists. They make maps of the floor of the sea. They drive special small vehicle there. They explore mountains, rocks, and valleys on the floor of the sea. Some of the rocks under the sea give us useful metals. Skiing is a sport where people slide across surfaces using long skis attached to their boots. Most people imagine skiing on snowy mountains, but it can happen in different environments. In winter, travellers explore ski resorts to enjoy the fresh air, the cold weather, and the excitement of moving quickly



down hills. Skiing is not only about speed; it also requires skills like balance, practice, and patience. Beginners often start on gentle hills, while experienced skiers try steeper hills. The sport is popular because it combines exercise, adventure, and fun.

Sometimes skiing takes place on frozen lakes or icy ground. Ice skiing is more difficult than snow skiing because the surface is very slippery.
