- The action that happened <b>first</b> is in the <b>past perfect</b> , and the action that happened <b>later</b> is in the <b>past simple</b> .			
Time Expressions	Example		
<b>Before</b>	He <b>had trained</b> hard <b>before</b> he <b>played</b> . / <b>Before</b> he <b>played</b> , he <b>had trained</b> hard.		
<b>After</b>	It <b>started</b> raining <b>after</b> he <b>had gone out</b> . / <b>After</b> he <b>had gone out</b> , it <b>started</b> raining.


