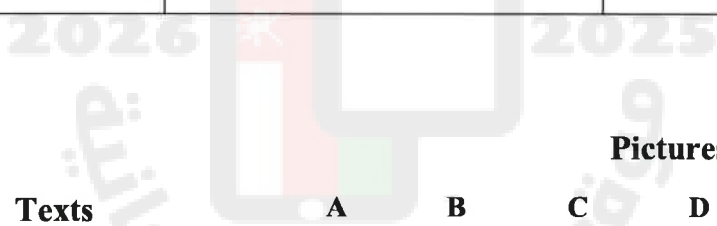

Taha Hussein is one of the most famous writers in Egypt. He is famous for his writing because it created discussions and new ideas.

Taha Hussein was born in Egypt in 1898. When he was two years old, he had an eye disease which made him blind. However, by the age of thirteen, he had memorized the Qura'an, which won him a scholarship to university.

Taha Hussein was one of the first people to be awarded a PHD at Cairo University. He wrote more than fifty books which were translated into different languages. He is best known for An Egyptian Childhood, which is his autobiography. He was awarded more than thirty-six Egyptian and foreign awards.

Taha Hussein read books about history, literature and Islam which gave him many ideas for his writing. He read the books in Braille and his wife also read and wrote for him.

He died on October 28th, 1973, overcome blindness and poverty to become the most famous writer in Egypt.
