Opinion essay

In an opinion essay **the writer states his opinion** and supports it with facts, evidence and examples but he **doesn't try to convince the reader**.

Steps to write a good opinion essay:

1- Decide whether you agree or disagree with the topic given.

2-Brainstorming: Try to think of at least two or three good reasons to support your opinion, including examples of why you think the alternative point of view is wrong.

3. Organize your essay into clear paragraphs.

- **Introduction** To write a good introduction you need 3 elements:

1- **The hook** (a general idea about the topic. It has to be at the beginning of your paragraph and it should be interesting to attract the reader)

2- **Context** (additional details that reveal the specific focus of your topic + your opinion in the topic) Say whether you agree or disagree with the statement.

3- **Thesis statement** (the last sentence in your introduction where you will tell the reader what you are going to focus on “the reasons to support your opinion”)

- **Body:** It can be 2 or 3 paragraphs. For each paragraph talk about a reason to uphold your opinion. Don't forget to start with a topic sentence where you will introduce the reason and back it up with details including examples and facts... etc
- **Conclusion:**

1- **Restate the main idea of the essay** and summarize it using different words

2- **give your opinion** (in my opinion, in my view, I think, I believe that,...)

You can also Use concessions (although, even though)
