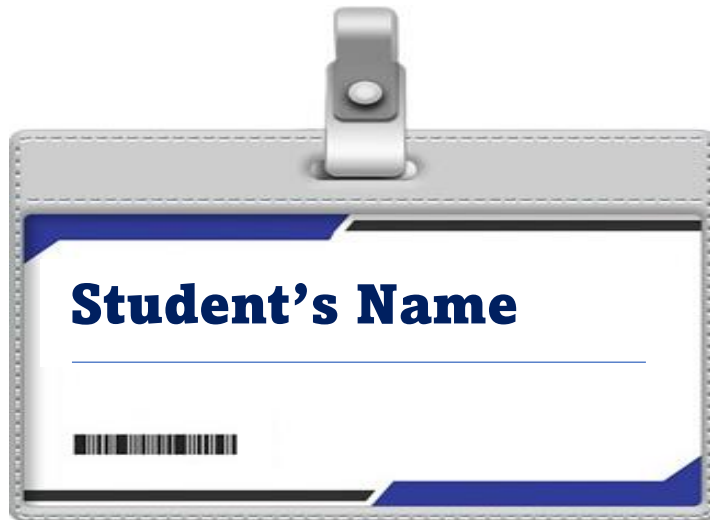
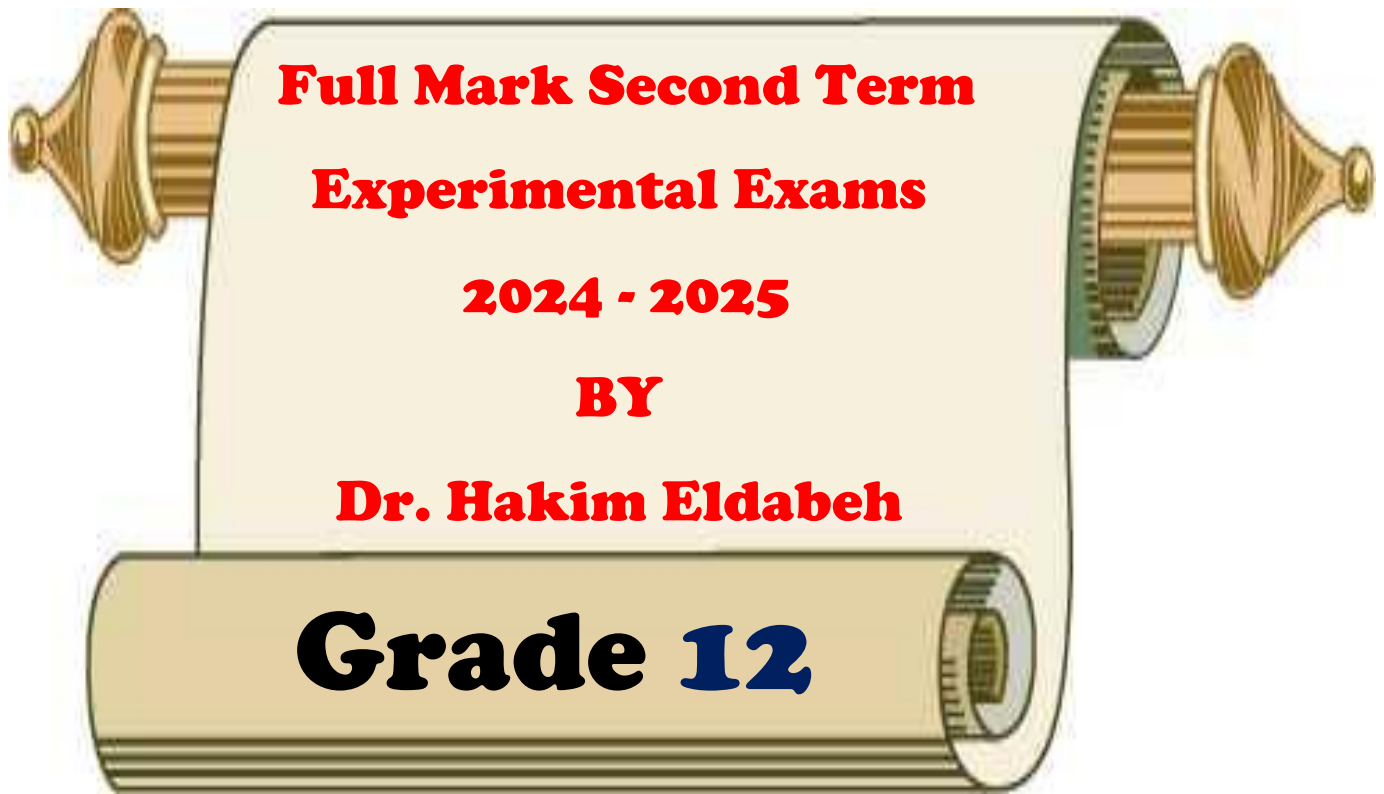

1 Man has lived in the rainforest for about 10,000 years. The Brazilian Indians settled in Amazonia on their way south from the Baring Straits and down through the Americas. The communities are small, and their methods of farming and hunting are designed to fit in with the natural cycle. The Chagga tribe, for example, have a system of farming which mirrors the structure of the rainforest, and which is extremely successful. They live on the slopes of the Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, East Africa and when white explorers found them, they were impressed by the sophistication of their methods. They have a three-layered system of using land which works in the same way as the rainforest, the canopy, the sub-canopy, and the ground level.

2 They have, in fact, created a 'food forest'. The canopy is made up of tall trees as usual where fifteen types of banana trees grow and are used for food, drink, and animal feed. The sub-canopy provides more vertical space for vines to grow. Also, it contains coffee bushes that provide more than half Tanzania's coffee crop. The ground is used for growing vegetables. Cows, goats, pigs, and chickens provide manure and fish swim in the water canals. The Chaggas are a good example of the way in which man can live in the humid rainforest without destroying it. The first explorers were interested in mineral wealth, gold for instance, and the spices such as cinnamon, to be found in the rainforest. Modern society is discovering, however, that these are nowhere near as valuable to them as the plants and trees to be found there. In the fields of agriculture and medicine in particular, rainforest products are proving to be vitally important.

3 In the 1920s, the American sugar-cane industry was saved from disaster when a wild cane from Java was introduced that was resistant to the disease destroying the existing canes. In 1970, the Latin American coffee plantations were saved from a similar disaster by a wild coffee plant from Ethiopia. Both these plants came from the rainforest. A new vegetable discovered there, the winged, bean, has been called 'a supermarket on stalks'. Every part of it is edible. A Paraguayan plant contains a calorie-free, harmless sweetener three hundred times sweeter than sugar. A caffeine-free coffee plant has been found on the Comoros Islands. A wild relative of corn could give perennial crops, so saving farmers time and money by not having to plant new seed every year.

4 In the fields of medicine, forty per cent of American drugs come from rainforest plants. Over 200 plants are being researched there as possible cancer treatments or cures. Quinine, an anti-malarial drug, comes from the bark, or outer skin of the cinchona tree. The snakeroot plant is used to treat hypertension and high blood pressure. Most important of all is curare, Curare is a plant alkaloid derived from the vine *Chondrodendron tomentosum* used as a poison by Amazonian Indians. Its muscle-relaxing properties interested scientists and it is now vital to modern **anesthetics** and used to treat multiple sclerosis and Parkinson's disease. This is only the tip of the iceberg. Research into rainforest plants has only just begun and it is certain that other plants will be found in time that have even more importance for modern society.

5 Over the past forty years, about half the world's rainforest has been destroyed. Trees have been cut down for the wood itself and for wood-pulp which is used in paper-making. Land has been cleared for road-building and to provide land for large herds of cattle to graze on. In Africa, rainforest has been burnt down to provide farmland for the poor. As the soil itself is poor, however, it can only be used for two or three years and then more forest has to be burnt down as the farmers move on, leaving disaster behind them. Any fertile topsoil is blown away. Any rainfall or moisture quickly drains away. Rainforest changes into desert.

6 The effects of this mass destruction of the rainforest go beyond even this and could eventually affect us all. Dark forests absorb heat. Lighter crops and grasses do so far less effectively. This affects the circulation of the atmosphere and can change weather patterns for thousands of miles around. Even more serious is what is called 'the greenhouse effect'. Rainforests absorb carbon-dioxide. Without them and with modern pollution, this gas builds up and traps the sun's heat inside the atmosphere. It is the largest and the most beautiful of the majestic mosque complexes in Istanbul. The mosque has a rectangular floor design and is surrounded by a large courtyard. The center of the mosque is a single square-shaped room, illuminated by more than 100 large colored glass windows.

The Islamic architecture art is made simple and matches the inspiring size of the central dome, which measures 90 feet (27.5 meters).

Arranged around the mosque there are several Islamic schools which were centers of learning in the Ottoman Empire, a hospital, and a row of shops. The complex was designed by the Ottoman master architect Mimar Sinan, whose buildings are iconic in Islamic Ottoman architecture

Text (B)

On a hill overlooking the Spanish city of Granada stands the Alhambra Palace built in the rule of Muhammad Ibn al-Ahmar and other Muslim Nasrid rulers (1238-1492) in the 14th century. Although some parts of the palace have been **demolished** during Granada battle, only three parts remain: a fort, on the west end of the hill, a princely residence to the east, and a group of homes and gardens known as the Generalife.

The courtyards of Alhambra Palace are prettily decorated with coloured stones, types of printed plaster, printed wood, and calligraphy. Some of the most remarkable eye-catching features of the architecture are the stamped geometric 124 white marble columns. They support and beautify the halls surrounding the Court of the Lions, which is in the heart of the palace. The Alhambra and its Generalife are the most famous and the best-preserved places of Islamic architecture. They were selected as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1984.
