<p>One of the most important Islamic architectures of the Istanbul skyline are the towering dome and minarets of the Suleimani Complex which stands on a platform overlooking the natural water paths and seas. It was built by the Ottoman ruler Suleiman the Magnificent between (1550-1557) at the height of the Ottoman Empire’s power. It is the largest and the most beautiful of the majestic mosque complexes in Istanbul. The mosque has a rectangular floor design and is surrounded by a large courtyard. The center of the mosque is a single square-shaped room, illuminated by more than 100 large coloured glass windows.</p> <p>The Islamic architecture art is made simple and matches the inspiring size of the central dome, which measures 90 feet (27.5 meters).</p> <p>Arranged around the mosque there are several Islamic schools which were centers of learning in the Ottoman Empire, a hospital, and a row of shops. The complex was designed by the Ottoman master architect Mimar Sinan, whose buildings are iconic in Islamic Ottoman architecture.</p>	<p>On a hill overlooking the Spanish city of Granada stands the Alhambra Palace built in the rule of <i>Muhammad Ibn al-Ahmar</i> and other Muslim <i>Nasrid</i> rulers (1238-1492) in the 14th century. Although some parts of the palace have been <i>demolished</i> during Granada battle, only three parts remain: a fort, on the west end of the hill, a princely residence to the east, and a group of homes and gardens known as the Generalife.</p> <p>The courtyards of Alhambra Palace are prettily decorated with coloured stones, types of printed plaster, printed wood, and calligraphy. Some of the most remarkable eye-catching features of the architecture are the stamped geometric 124 white marble columns. They support and beautify the halls surrounding the <i>Court of the Lions</i>, which is in the heart of the palace. The Alhambra and its Generalife are the most famous and the best-preserved places of Islamic architecture. They were selected as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1984.</p>
