1 What do you think of when you hear the word desert? The assumption that many people make is that all deserts are endless sand dunes under a **blistering** sun. This is true of some deserts, but not all. Scientists define a desert not by how hot a region is, but by how much rainfall that region receives. A true desert is defined as any place that receives fewer than 150 milliliters. Deserts can be hot or cold. Deserts can be found in many landforms. Only some deserts have miles of windblown sand, while others may be barren rock or stone. There are deserts that contain large mountains and canyons. Much desert land is simply dry soil.

2 Deserts not only get very little rain, but they also have very few clouds. In hot deserts, the sun beats down during the day, causing any water to evaporate. At night, with no clouds to hold in the warm air, the desert cools rapidly and may become quite cold. During the winter, the Gobi in central Asia may have nighttime temperatures as low as -40°C , and the daytime temperatures may not get above freezing for weeks.

3 Many conditions cause hot deserts to form. Many hot deserts lie between 20° and 40° north and south of the equator. Hot air from the equator holds great amounts of moisture as rain. The cool, dry air remaining passes over the desert areas. It heats up, then flows back to the equator, picking up any moisture and leaving dry land behind it.

4 People also contribute to the formation of deserts. Much of the area that is now the Sahara of northern Africa was once forest and grassland. While this area's transformation to desert has been caused mostly by climate changes over thousands of years, human activity may be causing the Sahara to keep expanding. People have cut down the trees. They have plowed up the grass that kept the soil from being baked and then blown by the wind.

The tree

The date palm is an extremely important tree in Qatar because it has many uses. Firstly, as a tall tree with long leaves, it helps keep people cool when they sit under it.
